SUBJECT: **Activities of the SPG/SSG for the 2011 Teachers' Month Campaign and Teachers' Day Celebration**

Date: September 09, 2011

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 49, s. 2011, the Supreme Pupil Governments/Supreme Student Governments shall lead pupils/students in organizing activities for the Teachers' Month Campaign in September and World Teachers' Day on October 5, 2011 with the theme, **"My Teacher, My Hero."**

2. Relative thereto, all SPGs/SSGs are required to do the following:

- Convene all co-curricular organization Chairpersons to discuss and plan the conduct of programs, projects and activities for the Teachers' Month Campaign and World Teachers' Day;
- Solicit support from PTAs, Alumni Associations, LGUs, NGOs, civic organizations, commercial establishments, and the community; and
- Lead and conduct, together with other school clubs and organizations, the following activities:
 - Posting of streamers, tarpaulins, posters and banners in bulletin boards and other conspicuous places announcing the 2011 TMC and WTD celebration and the line-up of activities, and commending the contributions of all the teachers in nation-building;
 - Saying "Salamat Po Titser" to all the teachers in the most creative and encouraging other pupils/students to do the same;
 - Organizing contests such as On-the-Spot Poster Making, Essay Writing, Thank You Card Designing, and other contests;

- Publishing feature stories or write-ups on teachers through school papers, websites, social networking sites, and other on-line channels;
 - Engaging local televisions, radio stations, and local newspapers and publications to participate in the various activities;
 - Posting of comments, greetings, pictures and others at the official facebook page of the TMC and WTD (www.facebook.com/depeddttmc) beginning September until October 5, 2011;
 - Organizing a culminating activity on October 5, 2011 highlighted by a tribute program, sportsfest and other fun activities for teachers
 - Ringing of school bells at 10:05 A.M. and reciting of the National Prayer for Teachers;
 - Recognizing teachers' efforts by giving awards to both active and retired teachers during the culminating activity;
 - Organizing fourth year high school students to handle classes on behalf of the high school teachers on October 5, 2011; and
 - Performing other activities as planned and assigned by the School Heads.
- Document all activities conducted for the 2011 TMC and WTD celebrations with clear pictures and narrative reports. Submit copies to the Division Office for collation and submission to the regional office. Post also the documentation at the official facebook page of the TMC and WTD on or before October 31, 2011.
3. Expenses incurred relative to the abovementioned activities of the SPGs/SSGs shall be charged to SPG/SSG Developmental Funds or funded through solicitations from LGUs or donations from private sponsors.
 4. All public and private elementary and secondary School Heads are encouraged to support all the activities to be undertaken by the SPGs/SSGs pertinent to the 2011 TMC and WTD celebration.
 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
