

**Subject** : CELEBRATION OF WORLD TEACHERS' DAY

**Date** : September 29, 2011

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1. The Baguio City Schools Teachers and Employees Association in cooperation with the Department of Education, Division of Baguio City, has organized a program for the World Teachers Day Celebration on October 5, 2011 at 1:00 PM at FVR Multi-purpose Center. This will be attended by all teachers and non-teaching personnel of the Division of Baguio City.
2. The celebration has the following two features:
  - A. Talks with the theme: MY TEACHER, MY HERO by ELLEN B. DONATO, ED.D., C.E.S.O. IV and LEONARDA AGUINALDE, ED.D., Vice President for Administration, University of the Cordilleras.
  - B. Teachers Got Talent, a search for talented teachers showing their prowess, talents and creativity in the arts of singing, dancing, drama etc. with the following objectives, mechanics and guidelines:
    1. Objectives:
      - a. To develop teachers' initiative to work together for a common purpose & goal.
      - b. To foster unity and camaraderie as teachers show prowess and talents.
      - c. To provide entertainment and stress free activity among the teachers.
      - d. To show prowess and talents of teachers.
    2. Contest Mechanics/General Guidelines
      - a. Talent acts must be presented by group (not less than 6 Participants and not more than 30 Participants).
      - b. Talent acts may be drawn from dance, dramatic, variety, instrumental and vocal arts.
      - c. Each District (Elementary and High School) should represent only one group of contestants or one act for the talent competition.
      - d. Each act (contestant) should be given a maximum of (5) minutes.
      - e. Participants should consider the following items when selecting and presenting a talent act:
        - e.1. audience appeal
        - e.2. projection
        - e.3. appropriate dress or costume
        - e.4. poise
        - e.5. staging-position and/or movement on stage
        - e.6. skills in areas of presentation (talent)
      - f. Animal acts, use of fire, groups requiring excessive time to set up and groups requiring special lighting are not allowed.
      - g. Use only cassette tapes of good quality.

h. The presentation will be judged according to:

h.1. Entertainment Value-	40%
h.2. Skill exhibited in field of Participation	30%
h.3. Showmanship	<u>30%</u>
TOTAL	100%
