SUBJECT : WHOLE DAY TRAINING OF BAGUIO ATHLETES FOR 2012 CARAA

DATE : January 27, 2012

1. In preparation for the Cordillera Administrative Region Athletic Association (CARAA) with Baguio City as the defending champion both in the elementary and secondary levels and due to hot weather condition in the Province of Kalinga during the 2012 CARAA, this Office is announcing that effective January 30 until February 3, 2012, all athletes, coaches, co-coaches, trainers, chaperons, athletic managers, delegation officials, and concerned support staff must report for the whole day training from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
2. All 2012 CARAA Baguio City Athletic Delegation members shall be excused from their classes for this purpose. All school heads are advised to make the necessary contingency plan for teachers who are involved in this activity. Make-up classes and contractual assignment must be provided to all athletes to maintain their scholastic standing.

This is also to announce to the field that all 2012 CARAA Baguio City coaches, co-coaches, trainers, chaperons and athletic managers shall meet on **January 30, 2012** at Baguio Central School at 3:00 PM while DepEd Delegation Officials, mess and medical & dental members shall meet on **January 31, 2012** at the Division Office Conference Hall at 9:00 A.M. Likewise, all 2012 CARAA delegation members shall assemble at Baguio Central School at 9:00 on **February 3, 2011** for final briefing regarding the CARAA. The departure of the Baguio City Athletic Delegation for the Province of Kalinga is on February 3, 2012 at 8:00 PM. The assembly area is at the PFVR Multi-purpose Hall.
4. The full support and cooperation of all concerned is earnestly enjoined.
