Subject : Panagbenga 2012 Dry Flower Arrangement Contest

Date : February 28, 2012

1. A division **Panagbenga 2012 Dry Flower Arrangement Contest** for pupils, students and Teachers will be held on March 2, 2012 at the Baguio City National High School Auditorium. Registration will start at 8:00 am and the contest proper is from 9:00 to 11:00 am.

This Dry Flower Arranging contest is open to all elementary pupils & teachers and high school students & teachers of public and private schools.

2. The objectives of the **Panagbenga 2012 Dry Flower Arrangement Contest** are as follows:
 - a. To showcase DepEd people's talents & skills in the Dry Flower Arrangement Contest as an expression of the arts.
 - b. To stimulate and encourage DepEd employees' and students' development through honest to goodness participation to Panagbenga. This draws out among them hidden talents in the field of arts and culture.
 - c. To provide opportunities for educators, students and pupils to develop a sense of appreciation towards arts, culture, nature and the environment.
 - d. To demonstrate that Schools, as part of the community still carry and uphold the same reputation of being able to support the ideals of Panagbenga through its participation in the City wide celebration of Panagbenga 2012.

3. There are four (4) categories for this contest:
 - a. Elementary Pupil Dry Flower Arrangement
 - b. Elementary Teacher Dry Flower Arrangement
 - c. Secondary Student Dry Flower Arrangement
 - d. Secondary Teacher Dry Flower Arrangement

4. The following guidelines for the contest are hereby stipulated:
 - a. Each participant will bring his/her materials e.g. Vase, dry flowers, floral foam and other accessories.
 - b. The dry flower arrangement contest piece for TEACHER & STUDENT must be a **FREE STYLE CENTER PIECE ARRANGEMENT**.
 - c. The maximum height and width of the contest piece should be 20” by 15” respectively.
 - d. Time allotment is **one hour and thirty minutes** only.

 - e. The criteria for judging are as follows:

A. Visual Impact & Presentation	15%
B. Artistic Merit and Creativity	30%
C. Use of Indigenous Materials	30%
D. Balance and Harmony	15%
E. Relevance to the Theme	<u>10%</u>
Total	100%
 - f. The judge’s decision is final.
