Subject: **REGIONAL TRAINING OF GRADE 1 TEACHERS ON THE IMPEMENTATION
OF THE GRADES 1 OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION CURRICULUM**

Date: May 16, 2012

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum no. 67 s. 2012, this office will conduct a regional mass training of all the Grade 1 teachers in this division on May 22-26, 2012 at Lucban Elementary School from 7:30 A.M-8:30 P.M.
2. The training aims to :
 - a. orient the participants on the salient feature and core element of the K to 12 Curriculum.
 - b. develop their capacities to efficiently and effectively implement the curriculum
3. The participants to this training are the Grade 1 teachers of the public elementary schools. The School heads of the public elementary schools are requested to join the opening program on May 22, 2012 in the morning.
3. Registration of participants will be on May 21, 2012. It will start at 1:30 onwards at Lucban District (office of the PSDS), Lucban elementary School. Participants are advised to bring the following during the registration:
 - a. beddings (pillows, blankets, bed cover, pillow case etc they need in sleeping)
 - b. art materials like pair of scissors, bond papers, paste, manila paper etc.
4. there will be no registration the following day (May 22, 2012). Late registrants shall be allowed but no certificates of participation will be given.
5. The first meal shall be dinner of May 21, 2012.
6. List of participants from each school/district must be submitted to the Division office C/O Dr. Lillian S. Pagulongan EPS-English or to Dr. Joseph T. Akilith for the printing of the certificates.
