

Program Proposal:

Program Title: YMCA BASKETBALL OFFICIATING CLINIC

Venue: YMCA Gymnasium

Date: June 29 – July 1, 2012

Rationale:

The YMCA of the City of Baguio, Inc. known for its sports programs have ever since promoted and enhance the development of sports in the community through various sports programs aimed to developing the interest as well as skills and talents that is beneficial for the individual's growth.

The YMCA towards this end, to be able to provide a venue for basketball enthusiasts has embark the conduct of the "2012 YMCA CUP INVITATIONAL BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT" where local players from the community can participate to exercise and enhance their skills and talents.

Basketball officiating in most if not all tournaments conducted every year eats up to 80% of the tournament budget, with no assurance of a 100% officiating performance from hired referees. Relative to this, to defray officiating expenses and to be able to conduct a quality tournament for the YMCA of the City of Baguio, Inc. the implementation of a basketball officiating clinic before the tournament is foreseeable.

The implementation of a Basketball Officiating Clinic to this effect shall help train YMCA Members as well as to serve as a refreshers course for the present officiating team to provide a better quality officiating during the conduct of the tournament. To be able to defray officiating expenses, the trained YMCA members can help as officiating officials during the tournament.

The implementation of the basketball officiating clinic will also serve for the possible grounding of a YMCA Basketball Officiating group that can help in the management and officiating basketball tournaments of the Association.

Objectives:

1. To provide YMCA members a venue for training themselves in Basketball Officiating.
2. To be able to provide the YMCA members a proper exposure and experience in officiating official tournaments.
3. To be able to provide an avenue for the grounding of a YMCA Basketball Referees Organization.

Methodology:

The premise of which a basketball tournament is to be conducted by the YMCA is in consideration of its being the inventor of the sport aside from being an annual program that is one of the preferred sports of both young and old.

The Officiating Clinic will be done in two consecutive days during weekends to maximize attendance which will come from YMCA Interested members and shall be facilitated by a local referee's organization that is accredited by the Basketball Association of the Philippines (BAP).

The clinic will be conducted in two parts, lecture and practical training on the official rules and regulations of basketball in accordance with the Federation Internationale De Basketball (FIBA) and the International Basketball Federation officiating standards.

After the two day clinic the participants shall then help in the officiating of the "YMCA CUP" as an output of the program. The participants will also have the privilege to continuously train and shall be accredited under the National Amateur Basketball Referees Organization in the locality (NABRO) who shall be facilitating the clinic as well as the officiating of the "YMCA Cup".

The program shall also be a way in which the YMCA can later on organize the participants as YMCA Referees who shall cater to the officiating needs of gym renters and all official basketball tournaments that the YMCA will be conducting.

Program Component:

The conduct of the Basketball Officiating Clinic shall be divided into two parts which shall provide the participants the proper knowledge of the international rules of basketball through lectures and to learn the fundamental know how of officiating basketball games through film showing and in person through practical training.

The lectures shall delve around the playing regulations of basketball, analysis of basketball game situations, officiating correctible errors, game analysis, fouls (offensive and defensive), responsibilities of coaches, players, and officials etc. The practical training exercises shall include the following; court mechanics, officiating mechanics, scoring and tabulation, and referee officiating hand signals.

The program shall also have a written and practical examination for participants for individual evaluation for accredited as basketball referees by the NABRO. Their officials function as referees then will be implemented and will be assigned to them during the implementation of the YMCA CUP.

Eligibility of Participants:

1. Participants to the basketball officiating clinic shall come from YMCA interested members who would like to be basketball officiating officials.
2. Participants must attend and complete the two day clinic for lectures and practical training to be eligible to officiate in the YMCA Cup.
3. Participants must be 18 years old and above.
4. Participants must complete and submit their application forms which will be provided for by the YMCA not later than one week before the clinic.
5. Participants must provide their own whistle during the clinic. (preferably Fox 40 whistle)
6. Application forms shall be made available at the YMCA Administration, Program & PE Offices.
7. Participants must be willing to attend regular officiating practices set by the NABRO.
8. Participants must be bonafide members of the YMCA of Baguio City, Inc.

Expected Outcome:

At the end of the officiating clinic, the participants should have ample knowledge on basketball officiating which will be evaluated through a written and practical examinations which forms part of the program. The participants following their exam validation and evaluation shall be provided by the facilitating group with a regular training program on officiating on their regular training schedule.

The participants at the end of the clinic and training provided are also expected to have mustered the basic officiating mechanics, definition of the playing court, analysis and basis of players' violations and hand signals which will equip them as referees. They shall then have the chance to be exposed to officiate on the YMCA CUP for the elementary level.

The continuity of training must be provided to the participants to enable them to be accredited official referees, the NABRO being the groups facilitator is expected to include the participants in their regular training so as to accredit them and hence, the grounding of a YMCA Referees organization can be grounded as a base club of the association to help in the training of our basketball club and to invite possible members for the YMCA through the club.

The grounding of a YMCA referees organization shall help in the implementation of our own basketball tournaments to defray expenses on officiating. They can also serve as referees for our gym renters and other organizations wishing to conduct tournaments in the YMCA gym.
