AND PARTICIPANTS TO THE REGIONAL SCIENCE FESTIVAL**

Date : September 19, 2012

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1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 26, s. 2012, re National, Regional and Division Science and Math Fair in the Calendar of Activities for School year 2012-2013, the DepEd-Division of Baguio City conducted the 2012 Science Fair and Yes-O Festival last September 7-9, 2012 at the PFVR Multi-Purpose Building. Enclosure one (1 of 12 pages) is the results for your information and guidance.
 2. Furthermore, this is to announce that as per Regional Memorandum No. 093, s. 2012, the 2012 Regional Science Festival will be held at Tabuk National High School, Tabuk City, Kalinga on October 6-7, 2012.
 3. Participants to the Regional Science Festival and the events to be contested are as follows: (complete official list of participants is found in the enclosure)
 - a. **Science Fair:** The first, second and third place winning Science Investigatory Projects (elementary & secondary cluster 1) under the two major classifications (Life Science and Physical Science) in the Division will be the official entry to the Regional Level.

The top ten (10) Science Investigatory Projects from the Cluster II that have passed the Scientific Review and Evaluation by the Division Scientific Review Committee.

Note: All with asterisks beside the rank are qualified participants/entrees to the regional level.

- b. **Science Quiz:** All the Division Champions in the elementary level (Grades III, IV, V & VI) and secondary level (1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th years) – there will be two sets of participants: Division Champion each from the public schools and private schools.

Note: Questions will be prepared in the Regional Office.

- c. **Sci-Dama:** Participants to this activity are the Division Champions in the following category: Elementary, Water Patrol and Power Patrol, Secondary; Electro, Sci-notation THI and Thermo.
- d. Division champions in Strategic Intervention Materials (SIM) for grades IV, V, and VI and secondary level (1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th years)

Note: This is teacher's category

- e. Division Champions in the Elementary and Secondary Level in Science Investigatory Projects (Life and Physical Sciences) Teachers Category
- f. Division Championship in research on Science (Elementary and Secondary Teachers Category)

Note: All IP SIM and Action Research entries must be submitted on or before September 21, 2012 at the Division Office to Dr. Esther Y. Melecio, EPS I, Science.

- 4. Each participant will be charged a registration fee of Two Thousand Six Hundred and Ten Pesos (P2,610.00) to cover the expenses for the honoraria of the Scientific Review Committee (SRC), board of judges (BOJ), prizes, administrative costs, extra essential services, meals, snacks during the duration of the festival, and fare going and coming back home. All expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against SEF, School Funds (canteen, PTA, etc.) and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff who will render overtime services on October 6 and 7, 2012 will be granted two (2) days Service Credits and Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) respectively. Grant of Service Credits is subject to existing DepEd and Civil service Commission (CSC) rules.
- 5. The arrival and registration of Division delegations is on October 5, 2012. There will be meetings of the different Working Committees at 2:00 p.m. at the venue.
- 6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

Note: There will be a meeting of all Division winning coaches on October 2, 2012 at the Division Office at 3:00 p.m. to discuss urgent concern on the preparation of the delegation in going to Tabuk City, Kalinga.
