

for Incoming Freshmen, SY 2013 – 2014

1. This is to announce the conduct of the **Baguio City National High School Admission Tests** for the following **Special Programs**:

- **Special Science Program (SSP)**
Test Date & Venue : 02 March 2013 BCNHS DepEd Bldg.
- **Special Program in the Arts (SPA)**
Test Date & Venue : 09 March 2013 BCNHS DepEd Bldg.

2. **Application Forms** for the above programs will be available in January, 2013 at the BCNHS Guidance Services Office.

3. **Requirements and Fees:**

3.1 **Special Science Program Pre – Qualifying Examination**

Each applicant must submit his/her :

- a. Duly accomplished application form
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag
- c. Photocopy of Grade VI Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCNHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement as of Third Grading Period

A general average of 85 % or higher; grades in Science & Technology, English & Mathematics must be 85 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in the other subjects

- d. Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 250.00) examination fee for test materials, honorarium and other incidental expenses.

Examination Coverage : Science & Technology, English and Mathematics

3.2 **Special Program in the Arts Pre – Qualifying Examination**

Each applicant must submit his/her :

- a. Duly accomplished application form
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag

- c. Photocopy of Grade VI Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCNHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement as of Third Grading Period

A general average of 83 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in any subject

- d. One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 150.00) examination fee for test materials, honorarium and other incidental expenses.

Areas:

- (a) **DANCE** - develops student's techniques, movement, vocabulary and a deeper understanding of dance as a form of communication and expression.
- (b) **DIGITAL ARTS** - teaches students to use elements and tools of current and emerging technologies to create works that express feelings and ideas; students will be trained to analyze and create work through photography, video, audio, computer arts, interactive media and film production.
- (c) **THEATER ARTS** - emphasizes on group work skills and live performance of spoken text in a number of styles and genres; contemporary and classical acting techniques will be introduced.
- (d) **VISUAL ARTS** - helps students discover what they can produce through their own creativity through paintings, print making, creative crafts and designs, computer graphics, sculpture, etc.
- (e) **LITERARY ARTS (English & Filipino)** - train students to explore and write their own ideas and experiences; they will study and work on all genres like poetry, fiction, non-fiction, etc.
- (f) **MUSIC : Band, Rondalla & Vocal (Choir)** - designed for dedicated music students with interest in vocal or instrumental music

4. **Filing Period** starts on 04 February 2013 at Baguio City National High School Guidance Services Office. Walk – in applicants with complete requirements will be accepted on test days.

5. **Individual Filing** by the student or parent/guardian or **Group Filing** by the official representative of the elementary school (Guidance Counselor / Adviser).

6. **Results of the Special Science Program & Special Program in the Arts Pre – Qualifying Examinations** shall be posted in the school bulletin board by third week of March, 2013.

The Top 200 Special Science Program examinees shall take the Admission Test (Final Screening) on April 2013 (*exact date to be announced*), provided they have maintained the following grade requirement in the Final Rating : A general average of 85 % or higher; grades in Science & Technology, English & Mathematics must be 85 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in the other subjects.

The preliminary screening qualifiers of the Special Program in the Arts shall take the Performance Test & Interview (Final Screening) on April 2013 (*exact date to be announced*), provided they have maintained the following grade requirement in the Final Rating : A general average of 83 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in any subject.
