YMCA LANTERN MAKING CONTEST

THEME: UNIFYING THE YOUTH THROUGH ARTS

DATE: November 24, 2012 **VENUE**: YMCA Function Hall

OBJECTIVES:

To be able to provide students ample opportunity to express themselves in visual arts and honed their skills and talents to be discovered and given recognition.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. The contest is open to all students who are members of Red Triangle, High Y and College Y. (Elementary 6-12 yrs. old; High-school 13 17 yrs. old and College 18 21 yrs. old.)
- 2. Lanterns will be done in school with one (1) adviser who will take charge or look to it.
- 3. Finished products should be brought at the YMCA Office on or before November 23, 2012 (Friday) 8:00 am 5:00 pm only.
- 4. The judging will be held on November 24, 2012, 9:00 am, followed by the Awarding Ceremony at the YMCA Function Hall. The contest shall have three (3) categories:

Category A = 6 - 12 years old Red Triangle

Category B = 13 - 17 years old Hi - Y

Category C = 18 - 21 years old College - Y

- 5. Only registered participants are allowed to join the contest.
- 6. All entries will not be brought at home by participants; it will become the property of YMCA Baguio to be used as exhibits.
- 7. Complete lists of participants who will make the Lanterns should be submitted to the YMCA Admin Office immediately so that they can start making their Lanterns in their respective schools.

PROTESTS:

- 1. Judges decision is final, irrevocable and winners will be announced immediately after the event.
- No contestant shall contact the judges in any manner in connection with the ratings.
- 3. Protest on the violation of the guidelines or conduct of the activity must be in writing and done before or during the event.
- 4. Protest will not be entertained after the event concluded.
- 5. Decision on the protest will be made by the Event Judges and Program Committee.
- 6. Any violation of the guidelines mentioned shall disgualify the contestant.

REGISTRATION:

- 1. Only duly registered members of the College Y, Hi Y and Red Triangle members shall be allowed to join in the contest.
- 2. A registration fee of Php 50.00 shall be assessed from participants to all levels.
 - 2.1 A corresponding membership fee for all participants in the College, High School and Elementary levels shall be assess from the participants whose membership with the YMCA has expired, and participating non members of the competition.

- 3. Registration of participants will start on October 15, 2012 at the YMCA Administration Office, Baguio City, Post Office Loop or call (074) 442 4766
- 4. Main advisers assigned for the school delegation shall be assessed the amount of Php 250.00 for renewal of membership or obtaining membership with the YMCA, equivalent to a Corporate Membership for a year with a corresponding privileges. Although YMCA membership is voluntary, we encourage all coaches to be members of the YMCA.

MECHANICS:

1. Each school is allowed to send four teams with one entry each. (One team is comprising of five members)

2 FOR TEAM A = Indigenous Materials

2 FOR TEAM B = Recycled Materials

2. The competition shall have three (3) categories:

Category A = Elementary (Red Triangle)

Category B = High School (Hi - Y)

Category C = College (College – Y)

- 3. Participants must provide their own art materials for the Lantern.
- 4. Lanterns will be done in school with one adviser who will take charge or look to it.
- 5. Finished products should be brought at the YMCA Office on or before November 23, 2012 (Friday) 8:00 am 5:00 pm only.
- 6. All entries will be the property of YMCA Baguio and maybe used in advertising or promotional activities. YMCA also reserves the right to hold an exhibit of the Lantern/s of all the participants.
- 7. The judging will be held on November 24, 2012, 9:00 am, followed by the Awarding Ceremony at the YMCA Function Hall.
