**RDC-CAR Memorandum No. 02 - series of 2012**

**TO :** All Heads of NGAs, LGUs, GOCCs, SUCs, SCHOOLS, NCCs, NGOs, Media and Other Private and Individual Organizations

**SUBJECT :** Contest on the Logo Design and Award Titles in the Search for the Cordillera Champions

The RDC-CAR recently launched on 31 July 2012, on the occasion of the closing program for the 25<sup>th</sup> Cordillera Month Celebration, the Search for Cordillera Champions which aims to recognize outstanding achievement by any Cordilleran or Non-Cordilleran, individual or group, who contributed significantly to the creation of the CAR and/or the attainment of its regional development goals. For this purpose, there will be a contest for the Logo Design and Titles of Awards categories.

The contest is open to all bonafide residents of CAR, aged 15 years and above.

**I. LOGO CONTEST:**

The logo must symbolize the outstanding achievements of individuals or organizations who contributed significantly to the creation of the CAR and/or the attainment of its regional development goals.

The elements: geographic, historical, economic and cultural symbols, which may be rendered as visual or abstract, included in the design must be recognizable even when the logo is reduced from its required size.

The winning entry shall become the official logo of the Annual Search for the Cordillera Champions Award (CCA). The CCA logo will be used in official communications whether online or in print, and for other purposes and shall become the property of the RDC.

**II. CONTEST ON TITLE OF AWARDS:**

There shall be two categories for the award:

1. Individual Category
2. Group Category

Individuals or groups shall be recognized as Cordillera Champions on the basis of noteworthy accomplishments in any of the following development areas: governance, social justice, agriculture, ecotourism, education, entrepreneurship, science and technology, environment, arts and culture, peace and order, community development, medicine or health, media/journalism, and sports, and others (e.g. international understanding, etc.).

A simple example of an award title is "Cordillera Champion Award" in the Field of Agriculture." The contest for award title/name aims to identify the best and most appropriate name/ title or word/s that is unique, original and indigenous to the Cordillerans, or which promotes Cordillera's identity through time (example: "Kadangian award").


III. MECHANICS


LOGO CONTEST	TITLE CONTEST
1. Contestants shall submit a single entry, consisting of a soft copy (CD or DVD) containing the logo and hard copies of the entry, one rendered in color and one in monochrome with a brief description of the logo.	1. Contestants shall submit a single entry for each category: Individual and Group Category
2. The logo entry should be original or is not in any way similar to existing logos or other registered marks or otherwise does not constitute copyright or trademark infringement. It has never been entered in any other competition.	2. The title should be unique, original and indigenous to the Cordilleran. It should promote Cordilleran identity. The title may be in English, Pilipino or Cordilleran vernacular.
3. The entry must be printed on an at least 200 gsm A4 photo paper.	3. The entry on the title of awards must contain not more than 100 words explanation/description.
4. Participants are required to submit a duly accomplished entry form with attached passport size picture, a photocopy of a birth certificate, a barangay certificate and a photocopy of a COMELEC registration or ID for participants who are 18 years old or above.	4. Participants are required to submit a duly accomplished entry form with attached passport size picture, a photocopy of a birth certificate, a barangay certificate and a photocopy of a COMELEC registration or ID for participants who are 18 years old or above.
5. Document requirements, together with printed copies of the entry shall submitted to Civil Service Commission-CAR, 116 Wagner St, Military Cut-Off, Baguio City.	5. 1. Deadline for submission of entries is on 21 December 2012, 5:00PM.
2. Awarding of the winner will be announced later.
3. The winners will receive cash award and Certificate of Recognition from the RDC to be conferred in a fitting ceremony.


