Subject: **DIVISION ORIENTATION-WORKSHOP ON THE K TO 12 CURRICULUM
AND THE MOTHER TONGUE-BASED MULTILINGUAL EDUCATION (MTB-
MLE) PROGRAM FOR KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS AND GRADE II
TEACHERS OF MTB-MLE PILOT SCHOOLS**

1. In support to the K to 12 Basic Education Program the MTB-MLE Strategic Plan and in consonance with DepEd No. 32, s. 2011, "Policies and Guidelines on Training and Development", a Division Wide Orientation-Workshop on the K to 12 curriculum and on the Mother Tongue-Based Multilingual Education Program of MTB-MLE Kindergarten Teachers of the Baguio City Division will be conducted on December 14-16, 2012 at Quezon Elem. School, Baguio City.
2. The orientation-workshop aims to:
 - a. Enhance participants knowledge and skills on the theoretical and pedagogical foundation of MTB-MLE.
 - b. Enrich participants' knowledge and skills on the use of mother-tongue (L1) in developing the language, the cognitive, academic and the socio-cultural aspects of the learners.
 - c. Contextualize existing materials for the appropriateness and relevance to the grade level and culture of the learners.
 - d. Demonstrate ability to apply appropriate methodology using mother tongue as the language of instruction in teaching kindergarten pupils.
3. The expected participants are the kindergarten teachers, Grade II Pilot Schools interested elementary school heads who are willing to prepare instructional materials in mother tongue to be used in the different learning areas.
4. The participants are requested to bring the following:
 - a. Dictionaries, laptop and USB, and sample of literatures written in mother tongue.
5. Service credits/COCs shall be given to all participants/training staff for Saturdays and Sunday in the orientation-workshop.
6. A minimal registration fee of three hundred pesos (P300.00) shall be collected from each participants to defray expenses for meals and snacks, certificates, cartolinas, pentelpen and other incidental expenses.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
