The 5th Search for the Young Math Wizard

Nature of the Contest

The *Search for the Young Math Wizard* is a math competition designed to excite and challenge grade 6 pupils in both public and private schools in Cordillera Administrative Region. It is an individual competition conducted by the Cordillera Regional Science High School.

Objectives

- The general objective of the contest is to contribute to the concerted effort in promoting excellence in mathematics. Specifically, the contest aims for the following:
- To encourage mastery of basic mathematical skills and to develop speed and accuracy in answering mathematical problems
 - To inculcate the values of hard work and sportsmanship in a world of mathematical challenge
 - To have pupils of their age experience achievements outside their school campuses and thereby putting their schools in the limelight of excellence and honor
 - To promote the use of ICTs in the educational system

Test Coverage

- Number Sense
- Measurement and Geometry
- Algebra and Functions
- Probability and Statistics

Date of the Competition and Registration

A fee of Php 200 will be collected per participating school upon registration on the day of the competition on January 25, 2013. The competition starts at 8:30 AM.

Contestants and Qualifications

Elimination Round. All bona fide pupils enrolled in Grade 6 in any public and private elementary schools in CAR as certified by the

school head are qualified for this round. At most two (2) contestants are allowed to represent a participating school.

Final Round. The top six (6) highest scoring contestants in the elimination round are the ones qualified for the final round.

Contest Mechanics

Elimination Round

1. All qualified pupils will undergo the elimination round.
2. This round is a computer-based multiple-choice type of test. Each pupil will be assigned to one computer.
3. The test has fifty (50) questions to be answered in fifty (50) minutes. The questions are distributed, not necessarily equally, through number sense, algebra and functions, measurement and geometry, and probability and statistics.
4. Directions will be read before the contest proper. Then, the contestants will be given a trial on how to answer a multiple-choice type of test in the computer.
5. Contestants will be allowed to bring with them only a pen. Solution papers will be provided.
6. ~~Only the contestants, the quiz master, and the ushers will be allowed in the testing room for the entire duration of the test.~~
7. The top six (6) highest scoring contestants will proceed to the final round. In case there will be a tie, a tie breaker question of the same type of test will be given until the tie is broken.
8. The top 6 highest scoring contestants will be announced at the venue for the final round before the round starts.

Final Round

1. The contest rules will be read before the contest proper for clarity and information of the finalists and audience.
2. The quiz master will read each question twice while it will be simultaneously flashed on the LCD screen. Timing and answering start after the second reading and shall end after the elapsed of allotted time for that particular question.
3. There are three (3) sets of questions prepared. Each set has five (5) questions. The three sets of questions with

their corresponding time allotments and point distributions are as follows:

Easy	15 seconds	3 points
Average	30 seconds	5 points
Difficult	60 seconds	10 points

4. Each finalist will be provided a desk, a whiteboard, a marker, and a whiteboard eraser; therefore, no paper and pen are allowed in the testing area. After the elapsed of allotted time to a question, all finalists should raise their whiteboards with their final answers encircled.
5. The top three (3) highest scoring finalists, according to their cumulative scores in the final round, will be declared the 5th Young Math Wizard, First Runner-up, and Second Runner-up, respectively.
6. In case of a tie in the determination of the top 3 highest scoring finalists, a set of questions will be given until the tie is broken. The weights of clincher questions depend on the time allotments for the questions (refer to number 3).
7. A protest regarding a question will be entertained only if it ~~will be raised before the next question is read.~~ The board of judges will deliberate on all protests and their decisions are considered final.
