





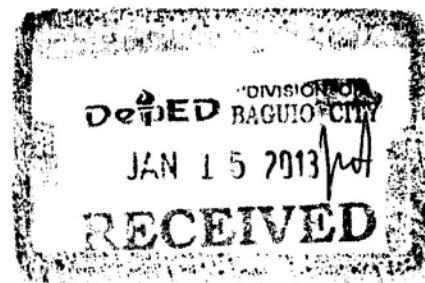

Greeting from Philippine Red Cross!

The Philippine Red Cross (PRC) is intensifying its program for youth and adult volunteers in its different humanitarian endeavors to make them more useful and responsible citizens of the country.

For this purpose, the PRC will hold its nationwide **Million Volunteer Run (MVR) Year 2** on **February 10, 2013** with the tagline, **"I CHOOSE TO RUN TO SAVE LIVES"**. The first MVR held on December 4, 2011 was a huge success with the participation of some 450,000 runners.

The MVR aims to serve as a driving force in advancing the spirit of volunteerism to address today's humanitarian challenges. PRC strives to empower the nation against the dangers of disaster by developing our youth and volunteers as humanitarian soldiers. The MVR also hopes to raise funds for PRC youth and volunteer trainings on disaster management and equipping every community with life-saving skills.

A minimal registration fee of **two hundred pesos (PhP 200.00)** will be charged for **each adult and/ or employee runner**. Further, a discounted registration fee of one hundred pesos (PhP 100.00) will be charged for each student-runner.

For the Baguio City Event, the starting and finish line for the 3K and 5K will be at Burnham Park, Lake Drive towards Kisad Road- Military Cut-off (3K Turn Around near Kubong Sawali) and Loakan Road (5K Turn Around near Forest House).

All runners are requested to wear **red shirt** during the Run.

In line with this, may we request for your support by disseminating the said event to all the interested employees and students of your prestigious institution.

May we further request your presence or your representative to the scheduled follow up meeting at the same time **Pledging Session** that is set on January 22, 2013 | 10:00 a.m. at the SP Hall, City Hall, Baguio City

Million Volunteer Run Year 2

About

MVR 2 is a fun run to be held nationwide on February 10, 2013, completing Philippine Red Cross' extensive network of one million volunteers.

Description

We are on a humanitarian mission to awaken the volunteer spirit of the country. The Philippine Red Cross is completing its extensive network of one million volunteers in order to deliver our services effectively and successfully through the "Million Volunteer Run 2", to be held on Sunday, February 10, 2013.

General Information

Last 04 December 2011, we celebrated the International Year of Volunteers by holding the first Million Volunteer Run. The run was staged simultaneously in 78 cities of the Philippines with a total of over 400,000 participating runners. With the incredible impact it has created in the recruitment of volunteers for the Philippine Red Cross (PRC), we have now declared it an annual event.

The number of natural disasters in the Philippines surged 50% last year, making the Philippines the world's most disaster-hit country in 2011. The two most destructive tropical cyclones in 2011 were tropical storms Sendong and Pedring. According to the Citizens' Disaster Response Center (CDRC), at least 15.3 million people were displaced, causing agriculture and infrastructure damages of Php 26 billion. The formula to alleviate human suffering in this horrifying buffet of disasters is the mobilization of millions of Red Cross volunteers supported by logistics and robust technological capabilities. Thus, the PRC has organized the Red Cross 143 wherein 44 volunteers (1 leader and 43 members) in every community are trained to reduce the risks of disasters, enabling them to respond accordingly to any catastrophic event that will strike the Philippines.

We know that you share our vision of providing timely and efficient humanitarian services to the most vulnerable. We want to have Red Cross first aiders, blood donors, and health and welfare volunteers in every home, school, workplace, and community in every corner of the Philippines. Attached herewith for your reference is the MVR presentation. By becoming our partner in this project, you empower our nation's most vulnerable against the debilitating effects of disasters.

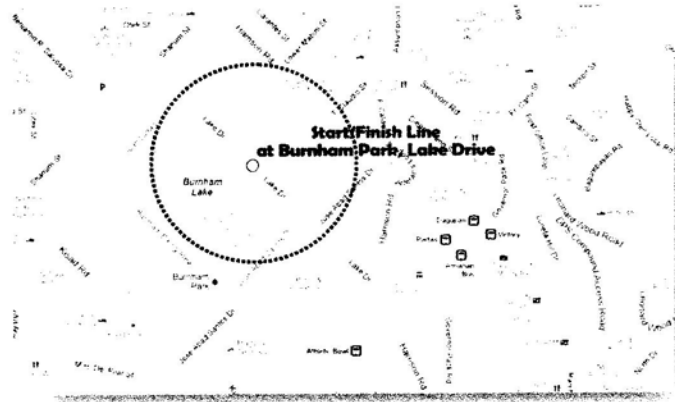


On February 10, 2013, the world will witness history as a nation unites to rise up and run for humanity.

Here are the details on how and where to register:

- You may register in more than 100 Red Cross Chapters nationwide and partner schools and establishments. For the Baguio Leg, you can register at Philippine Red Cross-Baguio City Chapter, 39 Harrison Road, Baguio City (near Land Bank and Jollibee Harrison).
- Participants 17 years old and below must secure signed Parental Consent. Waiver Form must be signed to qualify for registration.
- MVR Registration Form must be duly accomplished.
- Payments will be accepted at any Red Cross chapter and other accredited registration outlets nationwide.
- **Registration fee for each runner is P200.00** with a discounted rate for **students at P100**. Each registered runner will receive an official Million Volunteer Run whistle.
- All participants must wear red shirt.
- A certificate will be given to all finishers.

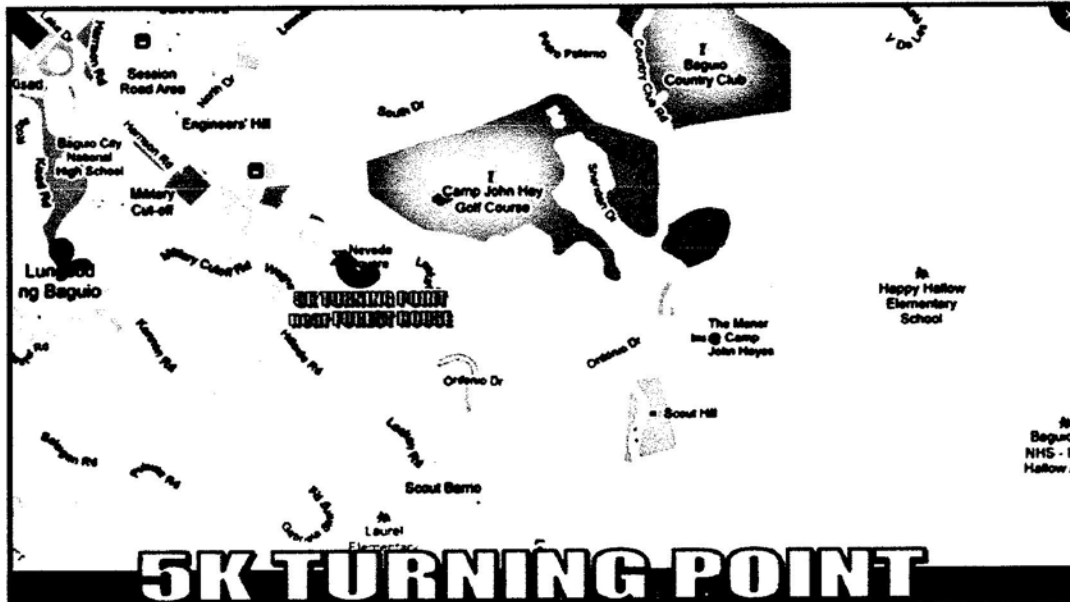
