4. The contest mechanics are prescribed below:

ELEMENTARY- Each district must send at least three competing teams for the tagis talino, sayawit and poster making contest.

A. Rules for the Tagis talino

- 1. The teams (3 members in each team) will compete in the easy (1point), average (2points) and difficult (3 points) categories.
- 2. There will be 10 questions per category that are related to the value of honesty.
- 3. The quizmaster will read the question twice and the team contestant will be gien 15 minutes to answer on the flash card then waits for the signal of the quizmaster's signal to raise the answer, the scorer will check the answer and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
- 4. The three teams with the highest score will be declared winners.
- 5. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask another three questions.

B. Rules of the sayawit Contest

- 1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the theme.
- 2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes including entrance, exit and other preparations for stage.
- 3. Number of participants must be 10 members (Singers and dancers excluding technical assistants who are singing and dancing at the same time.
- 4. Contestants may use props and other stage sets.
- 5. Live accompaniments are required and no lip synch.
- 6. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements

C. Rules of the On the Spot Poster Making Contest

- 1. Contestant are advised to bring the following materials

- 2. Contestant are given 3 hours time allotment to finish their work

Song Composition Contest

A. Solo singing contest

- 1. There must be a single entry coming from the schools either a male or female
- 2. The contestant should sing live with accompaniment (guitar or piano)
- 3. Original Composition Song about Honesty in Filipino should be interpreted
- 4. The criteria are

a. Adherence to the Theme	
b. Originality	25%
C. Scoring/Musicality /Interpretation	30%
d. Overall Impact	10%

B. Duet singing contest

- 1. There must be a single entry coming from the secondary school of a male and female tandem.
- 2. The contestant should sing live with accompaniment (guitar or piano)
- 3. Original Composition Song about Honesty in English should be interpreted
- 4. The criteria are

a.	Adherence to the Theme	35%
b.	Originality	25%
c.	Scoring/Musicality /Interpretation	30%
d.	Overall Impact	10%

- C. The melody and text/lyrics of the song must be entirely original.
- D. It must not have been entered in any song writing competition, published, recorded, and or released in the Philippines or abroad:
- E. The song must not exceed 5 minutes and 30 seconds in length including intro and extro
- F. The text/lyric must be consistent with the given theme.
- G. Each songwriter or a collaboration of songwriters (lyricist/s and composer/s) may submit only one entry.
- 1. The lyricist and interpreter of the song will be given cash awards and certificates
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
