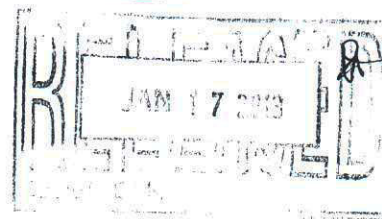

2013 Skills Exhibition REGIONAL TECHNOLYMPICS



TO: School Division Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
Heads, Principals, Vocational Administrators of STVE Schools
Division and Regional EPP/TLE/TVE Education Supervisors/Coordinators

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 115 s. 2012 **"Regional Skills Development and Competition (RSDC-TECHNOLYMPICS)"**, dated October 15, 2012. DepEd Memorandum No. 205, s. 2012, **"2013 NATIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS GUIDELINES"** dated Nov. 13, 2012, Enclosure No. 1 to DepED Memo No. 205 s. 2012 **"Revised Implementing Guidelines for the 2013 Skills Exhibition NATIONAL TECHNOLYMPICS"** consisting of skills exhibition in the different fields, in April 2013, to be hosted by Region VIII, the Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region (DepED-CAR) will conduct the **2013 Skills Exhibition REGIONAL TECHNOLYMPICS** adopting the guidelines in the aforesaid memoranda. The Regional Technolympics shall be held at the Tadian School of Arts & Trades, Tadian, Mountain Province on February 21-23, 2013.
2. Relative hereto, reports on the conduct of the **Division Level Technolympics** and the list of the Official Division Delegation to the 2013 Skills Exhibition REGIONAL TECHNOLYMPICS shall be submitted to DepED-CAR, Regional Office-c/o Secondary Education Division on or before January 31, 2013.
3. All coaches and contestants are required to submit the following documents to their respective Division Supervisor/Coordinator in charge of TLE/TVE/Tecnolympics on or before January 24, 2013 for validation. These shall be submitted to contest administrators during the solidarity meeting:
 - a. For Contestants
 - Certification by the school heads that the participant is a bonafide students enrolled in Public (Elementary, General or Technical Vocational) or private Elementary and High School Schools during the School Year 2012-2013.
 - The school principal/school head shall certify that the students are enrolled in the field of specialization where they are competing and participating.
 - Photocopied school I.D.
 - Form 137 with 2x2 I.D. picture attached
 - b. For Coaches
 - Certification from the principal that the teacher is a bonafide staff of the school being represented.
 - Certification from the principal of the teacher's designation as the adviser/coach of the student participant.
 - Service Record
 - Photocopied school I.D.
4. Travel of participants to the skills competitions shall be on official business. The registration fee for elementary pupil contestant is One Thousand Pesos (Php.1,000.00) while the registration fee for each secondary student participant and elementary & secondary adult participant is One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos. (Php 1,200.00). This will cover the expenses for board and lodging, some contest materials, token for non-DepEd Personnel, judges, technical and evaluation committee and operational expenses. Registration fee and other incidental expenses are chargeable against Division funds/local funds/PTA funds and other available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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5. A Solidarity Meeting shall be held at Tadian School of Arts & Trades open gym on February 21, 2013 at 3:00 o' clock P.M. All coaches, outside judges contest administrators, contest secretaries, Division Supervisors/Coordinators of EPP/TLE/TVE and members of the different committees are required to attend.
6. The first meal will be dinner of February 21, 2012 and the last meal will be breakfast of February 24, 2013.
7. A two-day (2) service credits shall be granted to teacher participants while two day (2) COC will be granted to the non teaching personnel.
8. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
