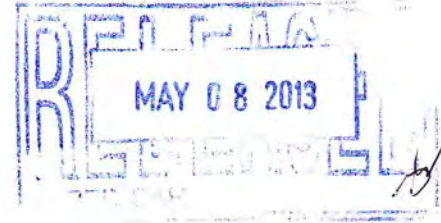

IMPLEMENTING THE BRIGADA ESKWELA 2013

1. Cororally to DepED Memorandum Number 40, s. 2013 entitled: **"Implementing the Brigada Eskwela 2013"** also known as the National Schools Maintenance Week on May 20-25, 2013. The DepED-CAR will hold a Fun Run and a Caravan on May 20, 2013 to Kick-off the week-long Brigada activity at **Calaba Elementary School, Bangued, Division of Abra**. The Brigada Eskwela is a school maintenance program that engages all stakeholders to contribute their time, effort, and resources in ensuring that public schools facilities are ready for the forthcoming school opening of classes on June 3, 2013.
2. The DepED-CAR regional kick-off activity will begin at 6:00 a.m. with the route of the Caravan to begin at the Abra Division Office to the school where an official kick-off ceremony will be conducted. The Culminating activities for the Week-long National School Maintenance Week will be held on May 23-24, 2013 at Sagada Central School and Ambasing Elementary School, Sagada, Mountain Province.
3. All DepED employees are enjoined to participate in the Brigada Eskwela activities by offering their skills or providing their support in kind to public schools near their respective residences. These Employees are given two days to do volunteer work on official time, provided that their work is approved by their respective heads of offices.
4. The Brigada activities in the different divisions will be monitored by the Regional and National Brigada Eskwela Monitoring Team during the week-long maintenance activities (Please see enclosure on Regional Monitoring Team) they will partner with the Division Brigada Eskwela Monitoring Teams/Committees. The Division **BE Teams/Committees** are advised to facilitate the submission of the **BE Accomplishment Reports** at the Regional Office on or before July 31, 2013 to give an ample time for the consolidation and submission to the National ASP Secretariat on August 5, 2013.
5. Transportation and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged to local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
