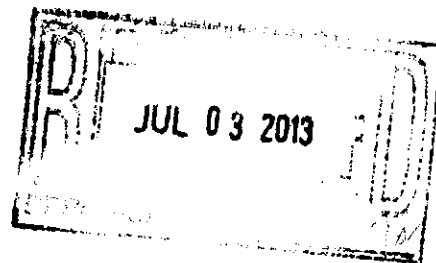

## MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS SCHOOL CHECKLIST

1. A SCHOOL MUST ENTER IN A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) SPORTING EVENTS PER LEVEL
2. Registration Fee
  - P500.00 (Per Individual & Racket Team Events/Per Event / Per Division)
  - P1,000.00 (per team Ball Events and Cheer Dance)
3. Official Registration Form - DULY SIGNED by the PRINCIPAL/REGISTRAR
4. Conformance Sheet Form - DULY SIGNED by the SCHOOL SPORTS COORDINATOR / COACH
5. Biodata and Waiver - DULY SIGNED by the STUDENT/PARENTS/MEDICAL DOCTOR/PRINCIPAL/REGISTRAR/ and TEAM MANAGER or COACH
6. Athletes Gallery Form - DULY SIGNED by TEAM CAPTAIN/COACH/ PRINCIPAL
7. All competing student athletes must take part in the Opening Ceremonies. As an added incentive during the Opening Ceremonies, Plaques of Recognition and Cash Prizes shall be awarded impromptu to the top three (3) schools for both elementary and high school under the following categories:
  - 7.1 Biggest Delegation of athletes and supporters who are physically present
  - 7.2. The School with the Loudest Cheer
  - 7.3. Best in Parade and Saludo
  - 7.4. Most Disciplined Delegation
  - 7.5. Miss MILO Little Olympics
  - 7.6. Cheer Dance Competition

### ATHLETES INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Original and photocopy of NSO per athlete or passport for each of the student athletes.
2. Form 137 and or Form 138
3. School I.D.
4. Certification of Principal signifying the athletes are bona fide students of their school
5. Three (3) pieces of a recent I.D. size (2 x 2) photo of all participants with the corresponding name tags and team captain/s indicated below each. (FOR GALLERY FORM USE)
6. Certification from the school Principal/Registrar that he/she is a bona fide employee and an officially designated coach.
7. Elementary students must compete in the Elementary Division only. The age limit for elementary athletes is from 7 to 12 years old. The cut-off year of which is the year 2001.
8. High school students must compete in the High School level only. The age limit for high school athletes is 17 years old. The cut-off year is 1996.
