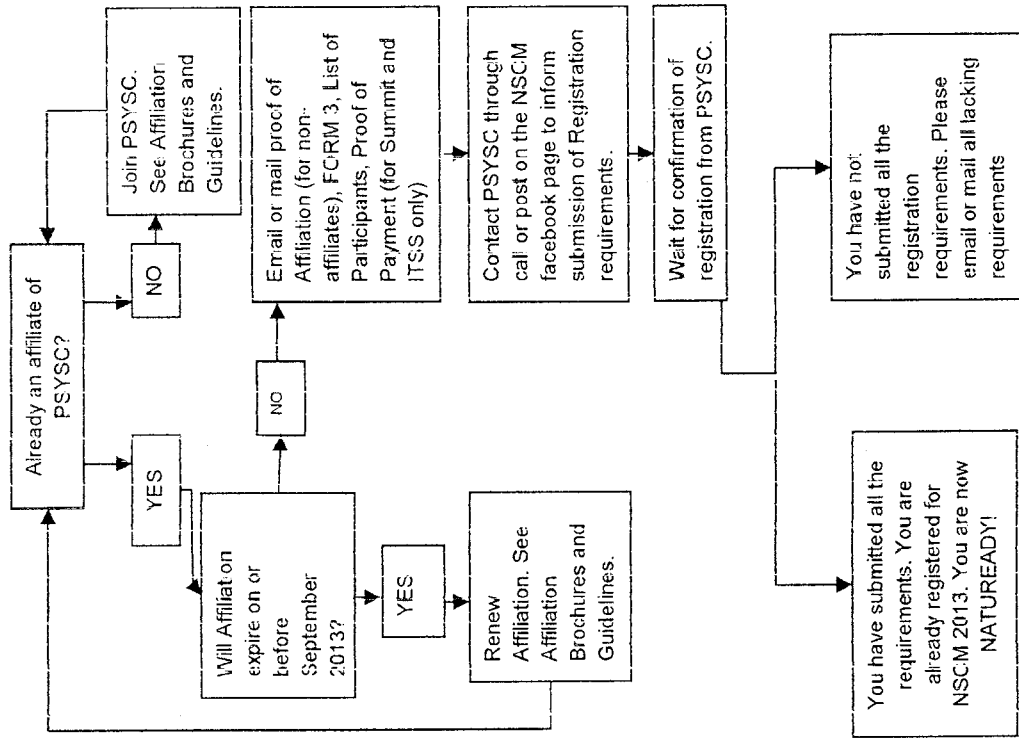

Frequently Asked Questions

1. WHO AND HOW CAN I JOIN?

Only science clubs currently (as of September 2013) affiliated with PSYSC can join all the activities for NSCM. For science clubs whose affiliation will expire on or before September 2013 and those who are not affiliated, please refer to the Affiliation Brochure and Guidelines. To join, each school should pass on or before **August 23, 2013** the registration requirements listed

below either through email to nscm@psyssc.org or mail to the following address:

- Proof of Payment – (For SUMMIT and ITSS only). The deposit slip of the payment (either original or photocopy) or the copy of the postal money order (PMO).

2. HOW MUCH IS THE REGISTRATION FEE?

There is NO registration fee for the PSYSC Science Olympiad, SUMMIT-MathSciAka and MathSciAka. The registration fee for **SUMMIT and ITSS is Php 250 for affiliates who will register or before AUGUST 23, 2013 and Php 500 for walk-ins and/or participants who will register after AUGUST 23, 2013. For non-affiliates, the registration fee is Php 1000 per participant.** Walk-ins will only be accepted depending on the available slots.

National Science Club Month 2013 Registration Guidelines

- 1) All NSCM activities are open to all science clubs currently (as of SEPTEMBER 2013) affiliated with PSYSC.
- 2) To register, the following requirements must be submitted on or before AUGUST 23, 2013.
 - a. **Proof of Affiliation** – for non-affiliates who will affiliate with PSYSC. This is Form 1 and copy of the deposit slip.
 - b. **Form 3** – the registration form included in the envelope.
 - c. **List of Participants** – the form can be downloaded from <http://tinyurl.com/nscm2013insurance>. We HIGHLY ENCOURAGE sending a softcopy to nscm@psyssc.org. A hardcopy of the sample form may also be faxed to the school upon request from the National Office.
 - d. **Proof of Payment with breakdown** – (For SUMMIT and ITSS only). The deposit slip of the payment (either original or photocopy) or the copy of the postal money order (PMO). For payment through PMO, send it to the address above.

- a. Attach all files in a single email with the following subject: **<School Name> NSCM 2013 Registration Requirements. Ex. Paulma National High School NSCM 2013 Requirements.**
- b. Each file attached should be named with **<School Name> <File Type> Ex. Paulma National High School FORM 3.**

3) You may pay the registration fee through:

- b. Postal Money Order (PMO) payable to: **Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs**

4) In filling up FORM 3

- a. Submission is PER SCHOOL. Fill all details asked completely. Check all activities that you will join. For SUMMIT, PSO and ITSS, **check the site where you want to participate.**
- b. If joining SUMMIT and ITSS, indicate the number of participants in the appropriate box. Also check YES or NO if you will avail the food of the school canteen.
- c. For the Payment Details, check what mode you have paid the registration fee. Also indicate in the box provided the amount paid for the SUMMIT and ITSS registration fee.
- d. For the Letter of Endorsement, let the Principal or School Head and the Science Club Adviser sign at the provided space. Make sure that all students are physically fit and allowed by their parents or guardian to join any NSCM activity.

e. A Registration Requirements checklist is provided for you as a guide.

5) For the LIST OF PARTICIPANTS

- a. For those who will email the Registration Requirements, an Excel file with the proper format can be downloaded at the <http://tinyurl.com/nscm2013insurance>. We will also provide a link to other PSYSC web portals: www.psyssc.org, www.facebook.com/psyssc. Fill-up the information asked completely. Use the name of your school as the name of the file.
- b. For those who will submit through mail, a hardcopy may be faxed by the National Office. You may also opt to make your own excel file following the format below. It is already filled up to serve as an example. Add more rows to add more participants. Print the list and mail along with the other registration requirements.
