1. Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 111, s. 2013 duly signed by the City Mayor, Hon. Mauricio G. Domogari, the DepEd-CAR, Division of Baguio City will participate in the 2013 Milo Little Olympics-Luzon Eliminations which will be held on September 6-8, 2013 at the different playing venues in the City of Baguio.
2. Participation is open to all public and private elementary and secondary schools.
3. All coaches and officiating officials (please see list of officiating officials who are recommended to officiate in this 2013 Milo Little Olympics.) are required to attend the Solidarity meeting on Saturday, August 31, 2013 at 1: pm at the Baguio Athletic Bowl.
4. The parade is set on September 6, 2013 at 12:00 noon at Lake Drive. The participation of officiating officials, coaches and athletes is a must. All teachers, non-teaching personnel, administrators and athletes shall be excused from their classes for this purpose.
5. The submission of pertinent papers of athletes and coaches is extended to September 2, 2013 at the Baguio Swimming Pool Area, Baguio City.
6. One (1) Day service credit/COC for September 8, 2013 (Sunday) will be granted to teachers, non-teaching personnel and administrators. However, a filled up and duly signed daily time record must be submitted to this Office on or before September 13, 2013 for documentation.
