1. This is to inform the final agreement during the meeting of Mathematics Teachers under Secondary Private Schools conducted at the Division Office last August 1, 2013.
 2. Participants to the Mathematics Festival
STUDENTS' CATEGORY
 - A. Mathematics Quiz Bee – Two (2) participants per year level
 - A.1 Coaches per year level will prepare and submit 2 questions each for easy, average and difficult to the assigned judges before the competition. To be written in long bond paper, 4 questions each in a crosswise, arial and font 12.
 - B. Damath Competition – Three (3) participants per year level
 - B.1 Players are advised to bring with them their Damath Board, chips, calculators, ballpen/pen.
 - C. Mathematical Investigation Projects (MIP)
 - C.1 The categories are individual and team. There are two (2) members in a team.
TEACHERS' CATEGORY – Open Competition (any year level)
 - A. Strategic Intervention Materials (SIM)
 - B. Action Research
 - * MIP, SIM and Action Research – will be submitted directly to the Division Office on August 30, 2013.
3. A registration fee of P30 shall be collected from each participant to defray expenses for the contest materials and certificates.
 4. Submission of the list of participants in 2 copies shall be on or before August 15, 2013 to the Division Office c/o Mr. Francisco C.
