# 2013 NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUE MONTH (NSCM) AND SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR SCIENCE EDUCATORS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Preclamation No. 28 dated September 4, 1986 and Presidential Proclamation No. 24 dated September 23, 2002 declaring September as the *National Science Club Month (NSCM)*, the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), will hold the culminating activity of the **National Science Club Month (NSCM)** and the **Seminar-Workshop for Science Educators** on September 26-29, 2013 at the Grand Men Seng Hotel, Davao City.
- 2. With the theme, Science and Technology Trends for Science Educators of the K to 12 Curriculum, the Seminar-Workshop aims to:
  - a. assess programs and projects implemented in connection with the celebration of the NSCM;
  - b. strengthen Science and Technology trends in the implementation of Science teachings in the K to 12 Science Curriculum;
  - c. enhance the knowledge and skills of Science mentors for quality instruction (using the strategies in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum);
  - d. introduce new trends in Science and Technology and find proper application in the classrooms in real life situations; and
  - e. recognize outstanding accomplishments of Science clubs in each region.
- 3. Science club advisers, Science teachers, department heads, school principals, administrators, district/division/regional supervisors and Science enthusiasts from both public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide are invited to attend the NSCM and Seminar-Workshop. Attendance to this activity is on official time only.
- 4. Activities during the Seminar-Workshop include plenary sessions, workshop, group dynamics, and interactive sessions. There will be presentation of projects and activities, including best practices and achievements, of each regional Science club.
- 5. A registration fee of Four Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (P 4,900.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover accommodation and meals from dinner of Day 0 until snacks of Day 3, seminar kit, t-shirts, reproduction of handouts, certificates and honoraria of speakers and facilitators.

- 6. To avoid disruption of classes of the participating teachers, school heads shall assign school personnel or volunteer-parents to provide alternative learning materials and activities, such as modules for reading and viewing materials in compliance with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
