**2013 NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUB MONTH (NSCM) AND SEMINAR-WORKSHOP  
FOR SCIENCE EDUCATORS**

To: Regional Directors

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 28 dated September 4, 1986 and Presidential Proclamation No. 24 dated September 23, 2002 declaring September as the *National Science Club Month (NSCM)*, the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), will hold the culminating activity of the **National Science Club Month (NSCM)** and the **Seminar-Workshop for Science Educators** on September 26-29, 2013 at the Grand Men Seng Hotel, Davao City.
