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1. In preparation for the District, Division, CARAA meets, and likewise Panagbenga and Philippines Series, this Office is informing the field that a division Seminar Workshop in Baseball will be held on September 14, 15, 21, & 22, 2013 at the Baguio City National High School. The registration and opening program will be on September 14, 2013 at the same venue.
 2. This Seminar-workshop is open to all teachers, non-teaching personnel of public and private elementary and secondary schools, hence, all heads are encouraged to send as many as they can afford as this will benefit your school, faculty, and students.
 3. All district PESS Coordinators are requested to submit to this office the list of participants per school for recording purposes.
 4. The objectives of this Seminar-workshop are as follows:
 - a. Equip coaches and officiating officials with the basic and advance coaching techniques and styles and the different skill drills in Baseball.
 - b. Address the psychological issues of athletes during or outside the game.
 - c. Apply the rules and regulations from basic to crucial with regards to judgemental and technical calls.
 - d. Identify the specific training and construct training programs.
 - e. Prepare the coaches bring their athletes to a desired standard of efficiency.
 5. A registration of Php200 shall be charged to each participant to cover expenses on certificates, handouts, and other incidental expenditures. *This registration fee can be charged on any available sources, school and PTA funds which are subject to usual accounting and auditing.*
 6. A two-day (September 15 and 22, only) service and certificate of overtime credits shall be granted to public school teachers and administrators and non-teaching personnel respectively who will actively participate in the sports clinic.
 7. All participants must bring with them jogging pants, rubber shoes, or any playing attire they may be comfortable.
