

Since its inception in 2011, the contest has received over 5,000 entries from high school students nationwide. Young essayists from Tuguegarao to Butuan City have been recognized and awarded prizes. This year, **BAYAN AT BATAS** challenges the participants to imagine and envision the Philippines in 2114, write what they see, and communicate their message to the youth of the Philippines in 2114. All entries to this contest will be printed, bound in book form and placed in a time capsule to be buried in a strategic place with instructions to future generations to have them read in June 12, 2114. The burying of the time capsule will be made to coincide with the **150th Anniversary of Apolinario Mabini**, the brains of the Katipunan. All participants in the contest will be invited to the burying ceremony of the time capsule.

The top three (3) essays will receive the following prizes: First Prize - Php 15,000.00; Second Prize - Php 12,000.00; and Third Prize - Php 10,000.00. All winning entries shall be read on-air.

CONTEST MECHANICS:

The contest is open to all Filipino high school students.

There is no maximum number of words.

Entries can be written in any language, English, Filipino or any regional language. Published entries may still be submitted as long as it was published in 2013.

Authors can only submit one entry each.

Entries should be encoded, double-spaced and saved in **PDF format AND Microsoft Word.** Font should be Arial 12. Entries emailed which do not conform to the rules may still be re-submitted before the deadline of submission by indicating it is a re-submission of an earlier non-conforming entry.

Criteria for judging are as follows:

Content and Substance - 40%
Relevance to the theme - 30%
Organization - 20%
Coherence and Unity - 10%

Entries may be submitted from September 1, 2013 – November 30, 2013 by e-mail to: essay@bayanatbatas.org. Please email a scanned copy of your high school ID, as well.

Details showing the name of the writer, contact numbers, email and mailing addresses should be placed on a separate sheet. All submitted entries shall be considered property of BAYAN AT BATAS.

The decision of the judges of BAYAN AT BATAS shall be final.

Winners will be announced at 7:00pm on December 29, 2013 on the Facebook page of Bayan at Batas and during the show or podcast that will be uploaded on http://bayanatbatas.podbean.com. Winners will also be notified through e-mail, a text message and a phone call. Prizes shall be given after proper verification of the identities of the winners.
