Subject : Game of the Generals and Dart Tournament

Date : October 19, 2013

1. This is to announce that the Division Tournament of the Game of the Generals and Dart which will be held on October 19, 2013 at Baguio City National High School Auditorium.
2. The tournament serves as the follow up and the application of the Division Memorandum no. 104, s. 2013 known as the Division Training on the Strategies of Teaching Game of the Generals and Dart last August 24-26, 2013 on its aims to see the impact of the training.
3. The tournament is open to all public and private schools, elementary, secondary, tertiary & open level (teachers and parents).
4. Registration fee of Fifty pesos (P50.00) will be collected from each participant for the students and One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) for teachers and parents for operational expenses including the prize and certificates for the tournament. Early registration is accepted at the Baguio City National High School – Main OHSP Office.
5. A one-day service credit and certificate of overtime for October 19, 2013 shall be granted to public school teachers and non-teaching personnel respectively who will run the tournament, serve as coaches or as participants.

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

A. PARTICIPATION:

1. There is no limit on the number of participants per school but scheduling of games will be on first come first priority basis for the first 100 registrants in the Game of the Generals and 50 registrants in Dart.

Participants are requested to bring their Game of the Generals set if possible.

C. TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

1. There will be three categories in the Game of the Generals and Dart.

a. Game of the Generals

2. There will be an elimination round, a semi final round and a final round .

Game of the Generals

- Bracketing will be adopted for the Game of the Generals during the elimination and semi final round .
- The elimination round will compose of four rounds. All players who earned three to four (3-4) points during the elimination round will qualify for the semifinal round.
- The semi final round will compose of three rounds. All players who earned six to seven (6-7) points will qualify for the final round.
- The final round will compose of three rounds to select the top three winners.

3. Scoring

- Win - 1 point
- Draw - .5 point

4. Breaking of Ties

- In case of a tie, winner over the other will be applied.
- In case of triple tie, the quotient system will be adopted.

Dart 501

- Bracketing will be adopted for the elimination and semi final rounds. Top two in each bracket will qualify to the semifinal round.
- There will be two brackets for the semi final round, Top two in each bracket will qualify for the final round.
- The first darter to manage his outing score wins the game.
- No dart pins no play

OPEN SCALERA

- Lady darters will attend a draw to determine the order of each player. there will be no elimination on this category but a final round.
- The first lady darter to close all the identified numbers wins the game.
- No dart pins no play

D. SPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT

All participants and coaches must:

- Accept arbiters' and umpires' decision with sportsmanlike conduct without disputing them.
- Obligated themselves to shake hands with the referee after the match as a gesture of friendship and sportsmanship.

E. AWARDS:

- Top three under category A & B will receive a trophy/cash and Certificate of Winning.
- Top 5 under category C will receive a certificate of winning.
- Certificate of Participation will be given to non-winning participants.
