- 1. This is to inform the Field on the Division Seminar on Values Formation and Classroom Management for Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education on December 22 23, 2013 at Brentwood Apartelle, Brentwood Village, Brgy. M. Roxas, Baguio City
- 2. The objectives of the seminar are:
 - a. To establish a network of teachers, administrators, and experts as an avenue to discuss/share ideas which will also serve as a support group to further improve oneself and the preschool program as a whole.
 - b. To set up a child friendly environment that caters to the maximum holistic development of pupils.
 - c. To have better perception and appreciation of oneself as Kindergarten teachers.
 - d. To have deeper understanding and respect of the rights of children.
