WHEREAS, the civic-military parade for the Chinese New Year has been scheduled on Monday, 03 February 2014, at around 3 pm from the top of Session road up to the Melvin Jones grandstand;

WHEREAS, there is a need to suspend classes in the elementary and secondary levels, both private and public, during the Chinese New Year parade to have utmost participation for the aforesaid major highlight of the celebration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. MAURICIO G. DOMOGAN, City Mayor, Baguio City, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the following:

SECTION 1. Classes in the elementary and secondary levels, both public and private, are hereby suspended in the afternoon of Monday, 03 February 2014.

SECTION 2. The City Public Information Office under the City Mayor's Office and the Division of City Schools of the Department of Education are hereby directed to cause the widest dessimination of this order.

SECTION 2. All executive issuances and orders inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed modified or amended accordingly.

SECTION 4. This order shall take effect on the aforesaid dates.
