This national training is based on the need to evolve an Ilokano for an intellectualized discourse, for the writing of intellectualized papers, and for rediscovering the registers of intellectualized domains useful for teaching, for philosophizing, and for scientific inquiry, which is crucial in the implementation of the **Mother Tongue-based Multilingual Education (MTBMLE)**. 


