REITERATING TO THE BAGUIO CITY POLICE OFFICE (BCPO) TO IMPLEMENT APPROVED RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE VISIBILITY OF POLICE PERSONNEL IN ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO TO AUGMENT SECURITY MEASURES FOR PEACE AND ORDER.

WHEREAS, schools serve as the second home of the pupils and students wherein their knowledge is being crafted, their skills and talents are being developed and their social lives are being shaped. It is also the place where they commence in reaching their dreams, be professional in their chosen fields of endeavor and be in their peak of success. The noble characteristics and decent attitudes are also formed along with knowledge for better quality of life;

WHEREAS, a school serving as a home should be free from harm and any prejudice acts so that it could result to diplomatic and harmonious place for pupils and students. Also, it should conform to the standard of righteous living and a safe school for learning;

WHEREAS, delinquencies, misconducts and criminalities are clearly rampant which lead to untoward incidents. Crime prevention group or any related organization in preventing crimes of the school is not enough to control and inhibit crimes; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Numbered 284, Series of 2003 [*REQUESTING THE VISIBILITY OF AT LEAST ONE POLICE OFFICER FROM THE BAGUIO CITY POLICE OFFICE IN ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO.*]; Resolution Numbered 281, Series of 2007 [*REQUESTING THE BAGUIO CITY POLICE OFFICE (BCPO) TO ASSIGN AND/OR DETAIL POLICE OFFICERS BETWEEN 4:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M. IN THE SCHOOL AND UNIVERSITY AREAS.*]; and Resolution Numbered 191, Series of 2001 [*REQUESTING THE BAGUIO CITY POLICE OFFICE TO STRICTLY INCREASE POLICE VISIBILITY IN THE UNIVERSITY BELT AND THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT BEFORE AND DURING CLASSES.*] were adopted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod (City Council):
