LEARNERS IN THE ARABIC LANGUAGE AND ISLAMIC VALUES
EDUCATION

Date : March 12, 2014

1. Pursuant to Deped Order No. 46, S 2013 on the Guidelines on the Madrasah Education Program and Utilization of the Support Fund, Paragraph number 1 states that the Madrasah Education Program (MEP), a component of the K to 12 program, contains a comprehensive standard or enhanced basic education curriculum in Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) for all Muslim learners from both public and private Madaris. MEP aims to engage Muslim learners with relevant educational opportunities and processes, as contained in the Road Map of upgrading Muslim basic education, and with components of Madrasah Education.
2. In line with this program, the establishment of schools with organized ALIVE classes is helping in preparing generations of learned and intellectual Muslims imbued with Islamic Values and spiritually prepared to serve his/her own family, community and the country as a whole.
3. In order to recognize deserving Muslim and Christian learners enrolled in the ALIVE classes, they shall be given the proficiency award in specific academic disciplines (e.g. Arabic language and Islamic values) and special awards (e.g. Best in attendance, Best in writing, etc.).
4. This applies only in the elementary level with organized ALIVE classes.
5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum and compliance of all concerned is enjoined.
