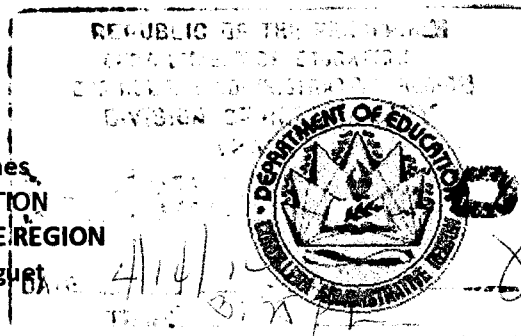

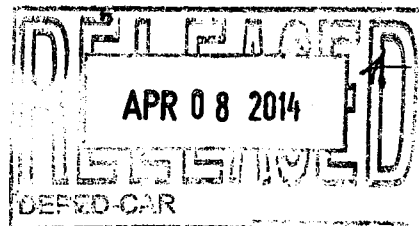

It is advised that non DepED schools which intend to implement early Senior High School for School Year 2014-2015 shall submit their letters of intent together with supporting documents to the Office of the Secretary not later than April 15, 2014. Ocular inspection and evaluation will subsequently be done by the Senior High School National Task Force (SHS-NTF) together with the Regional Quality Assurance and implement the intended senior high school track and strand will be subject to the favorable recommendation of the SHS-NTF and RQAAT.

PERMIT/PERMIT/RECOGNITION TO NON-DEPED
SCHOOLS STARTING SY 2014-15

1. Relative to the 2014 application of non-DepEd schools to offer early implementation of Senior High School (SHS), please be guided by the following guidelines.
2. The Regional Directors may sign and issue the Senior High School (SHS) Provisional Permit/Permit/Recognition to open and operate a Senior High School (Grades 11 and 12) to qualified non-DepEd schools starting SY 2014-15. The issuance is based on the favorable recommendation of the Senior High School National Task Force (SHS-NTF) chairperson following the evaluation of the SHS documentary requirements and the ocular inspection conducted by the assigned SHS-NTF evaluator and the Regional Quality Assurance and Accountability Team (RQAAT) evaluators, respectively.
3. The permit shall specify the approved SHS track and/or strand of the school. The template for the permit is attached as enclosure 1.
4. The SHS-NTF chairperson will coordinate with your office on the details of the ocular inspection to qualified schools that applied to offer the SHS Program in SY 2014-15.
