Dear Dr. Bringas:

Greetings from the Baguio City Chapter of the Philippine Red Cross!

The Baguio City Chapter of the Philippine Red Cross in its pursuant to the Republic Act (RA) No. 10072 entitled "*Philippine Red Cross Act of 2009*":

Section 4. Purposes. (g) To devise such means as to make every citizen and/or resident of the Philippines a member of the Philippine Red Cross.

Section 6. Membership - Membership in the Philippine Red Cross shall be open to the entire population in the Philippines regardless of citizenship. Any contribution to the Philippine Red Cross Annual Fund Campaign shall entitle the contributor to membership for one (1) year and the said contribution shall be deductible in full for taxation purposes.

And as supported with **DepEd Order No.38 s. 2005** *Recognition of the Red Cross Youth as Official Co-Curricular Organization in the Schools*:

4. Accordingly, all concerned are encouraged to assist and support the **establishment of the RCY Chapters in the schools**. All elementary pupils and secondary students are encouraged to enlist as members of the Junior Red Cross (JRC) and the Senior Red Cross Youth (SRCY), respectively. Likewise, the school administrator shall **designate a teacher to serve as adviser** of the Red Cross Youth Council.

And likewise supported by the **DepEd M.O.A. with the Philippine Red Cross**, signed last February 28, 2008 by former Secretary of Education Hon. Jesli A. Lapus and PRC Chairman/CEO former Senator Richard J. Gordon with undertakings of the first party as follows:

1.1 DepEd shall ensure that all schools both elementary and high schools from public and private schools shall establish a Red Cross Youth Council.

1.2 DepEd shall endeavor that every Red Cross Youth Council will have **at least forty four (44) members** – 43 youth members and One (1) Red Cross Youth Adviser.

1.3 DepEd shall undertake to integrate in basic education curriculum topics on **Disaster preparation, health, Basic First Aid, Basic Life Support and the International Humanitarian Law**.

1.4 Whenever possible, schools shall have **at least two (2) teachers** – trainers for First Aid and PRC.

1.5 DepEd shall encourage students to support the **Red Cross Youth Membership Fund Drive**

1.6 DepEd shall encourage all schools to have **at least two (2) outreach/community development programs every school year** in partnership with PRC.

Relative to this, may we request your good office to help us disseminate to the School Heads our campaign on membership and the Red Cross Youth 143 Volunteers (RCY). Below are the aims of the RCY and member benefits.

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The RCY aims to:

- a. inculcate humanitarian values;
- b. instill the practice of healthy lifestyle;
- c. enhance youth leadership skills through service delivery; and
- d. advocate national/international friendship.

Membership program with ACCIDENT BENEFITS:

- a. To become a member, the full name, birth date and payment must be given to the Red Cross and an ID will be issued out for each member
- b. Members are insured from the time of membership until the same date next year, and anywhere around the world
- c. Members can also avail of the trainings offered by the Red Cross

Greetings from the Baguio City Chapter of the Philippine Red Cross!

The Baguio City Chapter of the Philippine Red Cross would like to inform and update your office on the Membership Program with Accidental Assistance Benefits which would be of help to the locality particularly the most vulnerable.

- The membership program of the Philippine Red Cross is open to the entire population of the Philippines regardless of citizenship between the age of 5-85 years old and the contributor shall be entitled to one (1) year membership which starts on the date of registration and ends exactly one (1) year after.

1.1 Minimum requirements for registration:

- Complete and correct name (First Name/M.I./Last Name)
- Complete and correct birth date (Month/Date/Year)
- Sex (Male/Female)
- Marital/Civil Status (Married/Single/Widow/Separated/Divorced)
- Payment Fee

**** 2x2 ID picture is required for Platinum Members only. ****

- The member will be issued an ID based on the type of membership paid and only one (1) ID is issued to each member per year.

- The member is legible for an accidental bodily insurance claim/accidental medical reimbursement (AMR) on the time of membership coverage of exactly one (1) year.

** Falls, fractures, bumps, cuts, animal bites, vehicular accidents, natural calamities, acts of terrorism, etc. **

***Dengue Fever is the only non-accident that can be claimed for the AMR IF AN ISOLATED CASE. ***

- The member is entitled to a maximum of sixty (60) days daily hospital allowance (DHA) if the member was hospitalized during the accident, and the DHA is also effective for claim in events of hospitalization on natural illness one (1) month after membership and for hospitalization on pre-existing illness is six (6) months after membership.

4.1. The DHA can be computed by counting the number of days based on the time and date of admission and discharge and subtracting one (1) day from the number.

- The member's beneficiary can also claim in the eventuality of an accidental death or an assault that results to death (AD).

- The steps in filing a claim is as follows:

6.1. Inform the Baguio City Chapter of the Philippine Red Cross within five (5) days of the occurrence of the accident to determine the requirements.

6.2. Gather and submit the following documents:

- Membership Claim Form (Available at the Red Cross Office)
- Photocopy of valid Red Cross membership ID
- Original Medical Certificate
- Photocopy of Hospital Records (Emergency Room Record/hospital blotter, admitting and discharge record, finding/results and clinical abstract.)
- Photocopy of Statement of Account (Breakdown of expenses, date and time of admission/discharge.)
- Photocopy of prescriptions
- Original Receipts (only cash invoice and official receipts are accepted.)
- Original Police Investigation/blotter or Barangay blotter (Please include name of involved, time, date, specific location of accident and a summary of events before, during and after the accident.)
- Original birth, death, and marriage certificate of member and birth certificate of claimant and burial receipts for **DEATH CLAIMS.**

- The allotted time for filling is thirty (30) calendar days after date of accident or date of discharge.

- Some of the exclusions are as follows: self-inflicted injuries, drug addictions, nervous disorders, cosmetic/plastic surgeries, dental diseases, congenital anomalies, AIDS/STI, pregnancy, war-like military service, any type of racing and people with hazardous occupations.
