
*Greetings!*

# **SPEECH CONTEST**

## **Contest Instructions**

1. Contestants must not state their names or any other identifying information ( e.g. name of school, city, province, ethnic background ) during the speech to avoid biases in judging. Contestants shall be referred to by their sequence number and will not be identified by name or school until the judging has been done.
2. Time begins on the first word uttered and stops on the last word. Contestants going over the time limit will be penalized with three (3) for every 30 seconds thereof.
3. The use of prompters, props, visual and audio visual aids is not permitted. Singing, dancing and dramatic presentation are also prohibited. The penalty will be disqualification.
4. In cases where technical difficulties arise/s ( e.g. malfunctions of the microphone, sound system or power shortage ), the contestant should continue to deliver his/her piece unless otherwise instructed by the Board of Judges (BOJ). The Chairman of the BOJ may require the contestants to either start over or continue from where the contestants stopped.
5. Only the coaches have the authority to protest in behalf of the contestants and should raise it to the moderator. Protests must be made immediately after the contestant has delivered his/her speech. Protest/s received after the next contestant has been introduced or in the case of the contestant, after the tabulators have collected the score sheets from the judges will not be accepted under any circumstances.
6. The BOJ will decide all protests in accordance with the official rules. The decision of the BOJ is final and no further appeals will be recognized.

## **Conduct of the Extemporaneous**

1. Contestants will draw lots 30 minutes before the contest starts.
2. Each contestant is given three (3) minutes to prepare his/her speech and another 3 minutes to deliver.
3. The topic will be given by the moderator on the day of the contest. Contestants are given 3 minutes to prepare and organize his/her speech. As soon as the bell rings for her to go on stage.
4. As the first contestant is delivering his/her speech, the second contestant is also preparing his/her topic. As soon as the bell rings for the second contestant to deliver, the third contestant will also draw his/her topic. As second contestant is delivering his/her speech, third contestant is also preparing his/her speech. This order follows till the last contestant.

## **CRITERIA**

1. Content and Substance – 30 pts.  
Relevance of focus on the theme
2. Delivery – 30 pts.  
Quality of voice, fluency, diction, pronunciation, and pacing
3. Language Use-Grammar and organization – 20 pts.
4. Stage Presence – 10 pts.
5. Persuasion – 10 pts.
