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





A. Bantayog Quiz Show – Inter High School Category

1. The Bantayog Quiz Show – Inter High School Category is a team competition between students of different high schools in the Province of Benguet and the City of Baguio.
2. Each high school shall register one team, each composed of four participants. Each participant must currently be enrolled in the school year 2014-2015 in the school he/she is representing.
3. The quiz show shall cover questions from Applied Mathematics, Science (Chemistry and Physics), Trivia, General Information and Current Events. Questions shall either be objective type or problem solving type.
4. The Quiz Show shall be held on October 17, 2014, Friday, from 1:00pm to 5:00pm.

B. Registration

1. A letter of invitation shall be given to the head of each school. A text message shall be sent to the Bantayog secretariat for confirmation from each school on or before October 10, 2014.
2. A registration fee of 350 Php and registration form attached herein will be collected on the day of the contest proper.

C. General Rules

1. The Bantayog Inter- high school Edition shall be a quiz-bee type contest open to an audience. The Final Round shall be entitled ChEopardy 2.X! and it shall be based on the famous American Game Show "Jeopardy."
2. Prior to the final round, a preliminary round shall take place to determine the teams that shall proceed to the final round. The five teams garnering the highest scores will proceed to the final round.
3. Scores from the preliminary round shall not be carried over to the final round.
4. Each contestant shall be allowed to bring a pen and only a non-programmable scientific calculator. Calculators shall be inspected by the quiz proctors before the examination. Scrap papers shall be provided.

5. Questions shall be read by the quiz masters twice. A copy of the question shall also be flashed in a screen for the contestants.
6. *Contestants shall be given a time limit to answer each question. Timing will start after the question has been read twice. Contestants may start answering while the question is being read.*
7. Rounding-off calculated values should be done in the final answers only; free-floating decimals should be kept during the preliminary calculations. Unless answers in simplified rationalized form are required, answers should be rounded off with the correct units to four (4) decimal places. If the required answer is a word or a phrase, *correct pronunciation shall be strictly checked. The judges shall have the right to ask the team to spell the word not clearly understood; misspelled word would invalidate the answer. Abbreviations and acronyms shall not be accepted unless otherwise stated.*
8. A protest may be raised by any contestant. All protests shall be forwarded to the judges for decision. Protests regarding a particular question shall be entertained only before the next question is read. Once the next question is read, no protest regarding the previous question shall be entertained.

D. Preliminary Round

1. *The Preliminary Round shall be composed of 3 rounds: Easy, Average and Difficult Rounds.*
2. Each round shall be composed of 8 questions. The questions in the Easy, Average and Difficult rounds shall be worth 10, 20, and 30 points, respectively.
3. Each team shall answer each question and shall write their answer on the cardboard provided. When the time expires, each team shall give their answers to the quiz proctors upon which it shall be checked. Failure to do so shall render the answer invalid.
4. *All final answers shall be enclosed in a box. Unboxed answers shall be considered incorrect.*
5. The five (5) teams with the highest scores shall advance to the final round.
6. In cases of ties, tie breaking questions shall be given until the tie is broken.

E. ChEpardey 2.X!

1. *Each of the five teams shall be given a "buzzer" which the team will press upon arriving on an answer. When a "buzzer" is pressed, the other buzzers will automatically be put off. A representative of the team shall say their answer clearly with the use of the microphone upon recognition of the team name. In the event that the answer of the*

team is incorrect, the other teams shall be given a chance to steal once until the time limit for the question in consideration expires.

2. *In this round, five categories shall be posted on the board, with a row of five questions below each category. The questions shall be hidden by a certain value which shall increase from top to bottom. The difficulty of the questions increases as their worth increases. Each team shall have a score multiplier of one (1) during the start of the round. The round shall begin with the quiz master choosing a category and the value of the question. The quiz master shall read the question and the teams shall buzz in with a buzzer for the opportunity to answer the question. A correct response shall add the value of the question to the team's score, and increase the team's score multiplier by one, giving them the opportunity to select the next question from the board. An incorrect response shall decrease the team's score multiplier by one (1), and give the remaining opponents a chance to steal. If none of the teams are able to give the correct response within the time limit for the question in consideration, the quiz master shall reveal the correct response and the team which selected the previous clue shall choose the next clue.*
3. *Asked questions either correctly or incorrectly answered shall be marked with an "X" .A correct response acquired from a question forming a row, column or diagonal of "X's" shall be asked a bonus question, shall be given the opportunity to choose the next category, and shall acquire the points corresponding to the bonus question. An incorrect response acquired from a question forming a row, column or diagonal of "X's" shall not be asked a bonus question and shall not bring any deduction from the score of the team. An answer to the bonus question, either correct or incorrect, shall not affect the team's score multiplier. The round shall end when all the questions in the board have been revealed and asked.*
4. *The minimum value of each team's multiplier shall be one. No team shall have a final score equivalent to zero.*
5. *Scores after the round has ended shall be multiplied to the team's score multiplier and shall be the team's final score.*

F. Tie Breaker Round.

If multiple teams tied for first place at the conclusion of ChEopardy 2.X! Round, a tiebreaker round shall be played. The tied teams shall be presented with a category and the question shall then be revealed. The first contestant who provides the correct response shall become the champion.

G. Winner

1. The team with the highest amount of points after the final round shall win the game and shall be crowned the Bantayog Inter-High School 2014 Grand Champion.
2. The teams with the second and third highest score shall be awarded as the first runner-up and second runner-up respectively.

H. Board of Judges

1. The Board of Judges shall be composed of faculty members of Saint Louis University.
2. The Board of Judges will act on any concern regarding the questions and answers.
3. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final.
