SUBJECT : 2014 DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

DATE : September 30, 2014

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation 267, series of 1993, National Children's Month (NCM) Celebration is held every month of October. This year's celebration focuses on the Child's participation rights with the theme "Bata Kasali ka, Ikaw ay Mahalaga!"
2. Relative to the celebration, this office shall conduct the Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents for Public and Private Elementary Schools to be held at the Pres. Fidel V. Ramos (PFVR) Auditorium on November 11, 2014 at 8:00 a.m. for the culminating program.
3. The festival aims to:
 - a. demonstrate the importance of belongingness to every kindergarten learners.
 - b. involve all kindergarten children in the different activities and hone their own potentials in order to strengthen their confidence and self-esteem.
 - c. provide activities which will encourage children to appreciate and continue their studies.
4. The different contest to be contested in the festival are the following:
 - a. Poem Recitation (English and Filipino)
 - b. Vocal Solo competition (English and Filipino)
 - c. Story Reading (English and Filipino)
 - d. Story Telling (English, Filipino and Ilokano)
 - e. Drawing
 - f. Sports Dance
5. Participants to this contest are open to all children enrolled in Kindergarten only for both public and private schools.

7. In relation thereto, each District (Public and Private) shall conduct their own District Elimination and submit the top 3 winners in all the contest categories for the Division Contest.
8. A registration of seventy five (P75.00) will be charged to each participant (Contestants and Coaches) to defray expenses such as certificates, meals and snacks of judges, tokens and other operating expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity. The registration can be charged against local funds or any other source of school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Submission of the list of participants and pre-registration shall be on or before October 11, 2014 to the Division Office c/o Dr. Thelma T. Dalay-on, Division Kindergarten Coordinator.
10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.

MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

VOCAL SOLO COMPETITION (FILIPINO & ENGLISH)

1. Each contestant is free to choose any song appropriate to children.
2. Performance time is 2 to 3 minutes including entrance and exit.
3. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used as accompaniment; however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.
4. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

A. Voice Clarity & Projection	25%
B. Rhythm	15%
C. Dynamics	15%
D. Diction	15%
E. Mastery	20%
F. Showmanship	10%

POEM RECITATION (FILIPINO & ENGLISH)

1. Each contestant will recite the same poem.
2. Performance time is 1 minute including entrance and exit.
3. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

A. Voice Clarity & Projection	25%
B. Diction	20%
C. Interpretation	25%
D. Mastery	25%
E. Costume	5%

STORY READING (FILIPINO & ENGLISH)

1. The contestant will be given 2 minutes for acquaintance with the piece or story.
2. The piece shall be delivered within 15 to 30 seconds.
3. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

A. Interpretation		50%
- Vocal Expression	15	
- Proper Phrasing	15	
- Timing	10	
- Pacing	10	
B. Projection		20%
- Voice Mechanics	10	
- Level of Confidence	10	
C. Reading Fluency		30%
- Accuracy	10	
- Automaticity	10	
- Prosody	10

STORY TELLING (FILIPINO, ENGLISH & ILOCANO)

1. Each contestant will be given 2 to 3 minutes to deliver the piece or story.

2. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

A. mastery of the Piece	50%
B. Voice Projection/Verbal Style	20%
C. Expression/Distinct Style	20%
D. Level of Confidence	5%
E. Costume	5%

DRAWING

1. Each contestant will draw on 1 sheet of oslo paper using crayons.

2. Contestants will bring their own materials for the contest.

3. The drawing should depict the theme

4. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

A. Relevance to the theme	25%
B. Creativity	25%
C. Lay Out	20%
D. Color Harmony	20%
E. Neatness	10%

SPORTS DANCE

1. The group is composed of 6 members but should not exceed 1 member.

2. Each participating group will create a dance depicting a certain sports of their choice.

Example, if they choose basketball, their steps should include dribbling, shooting, throwing and catching.


3. Time of performance should not exceed 4 minutes including entrance and exit.

4. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

A. Creativity	25%
B. Choreography	20%
C. Grace and Footwork	25%
D. Mastery and Coordination	25%
E. Attire	5%
