



Date: November 13,2014

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1. Presidential Proclamation no. 479 declares the month of November of every year as The National Values Education Month. The theme of this year's celebration is "Ang Guro ng Edukasyonsa Pagpapakatao sa K to 12 Enhanced Basic Education Curriculum".
  2. To celebrate Values Month this year, the division will have a number of activities. It will be highlighted with a Division competition with the different contest: Tagistalino,Poster making Contest and sayawit on November 20, 2014 at Guisad Valley National High School from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.This will be followed by a training workshop for ESP teachers ( secondary ) on November 21 and 22, 2014 at Bonifacio Elementary School, Lions International Building, Bado Dangwa St. Guisad , Baguio City

3. The objectives of competition/seminar workshop are:

- a. To deepen the knowledge of teachers for positive identity, work ethics and spirituality as one of the many factors of effective, responsible and model teacher in the implementation of Esp –K-12 EBEC through a seminar workshop
- b. To develop the competencies in the teaching of Esp – k to 12 with the integration of information and communication technology through a seminar workshop
- c. To show the integration of ICT in the teaching of EsP in the K-12 curriculum through actual teaching demo
- d. To orient EsP teachers on the rationale, dynamics and nature of curriculum for multi-cultural learners through a seminar
- e. To prepare a curriculum brief and web for Edukasyonsa Pagpapakatao needed in teaching specific competencies through a workshop
- f. To provide opportunities for students from the different secondary public schools of Baguio City to come together and discover and develop their talent through different literary and musical contest

## 5. CRITERIA AND MECHANICS OF THE DIFFERENT CONTEST

### TAGIS TALINO

- a. The Teams will compete in the easy (1 pt) Average (2 pts) and difficult (3 pts) categories
- b. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the learning competencies found in the resources material as provide in Edukasyonsapagpapakatao 7,8,9 and Values Education for the fourth year.
- c. The quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team will be given 15 seconds to choose their answer from them, then they wait for the quizmaster’s signal to raise their answers. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
- d. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners.
- e. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask a new set of three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.

## SAYAWIT

- a. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the Values Education month's theme.
- b. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes including entrance, exit and other preparation for stage.
- c. Number of participants should be from 7 – 10 (singer and dancers, including technical assistants/instrumentalist, who are singing and dancing at the same time.
- d. Contestants may use props and other stage set.
- e. Live accompaniment is required and no lip-synchs.
- f. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements.
- g. There should be no individual singing with the use of the microphone.

### Criteria in judging

1. Concept and relevance to the theme	40 %
2. Choreography and staging	20 %
3. Musicality	20 %
4. Props, costumes and audio visual effects	20 %
