Subject: **GUIDELINES IN THE CONDUCT OF THE 12<sup>th</sup> STUDENT TECHNOLYMPICS  
OF THE PHILIPPINES DIVISION SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AND COMPETITION**

Date : December 10, 2014

In line with the conduct of the Student Technolympics of the Philippines – Division Skills Development on Thursday and Saturday, December 11 & 13, 2014 at the different venues, the National guidelines in judging will be in force and remain as our guide in the conduct of the said competition.

- a. All coaches and contestants are required to attend the opening program, 8:00 a.m. at the designated venue.
- b. First and second winners in the District (elementary) will attend the Division 2014 Technolympics at Lucban Elementary School. While venue for Secondary Industrial Arts in BCNHS main, Home Economics and Agrifishery in Quezon Hill National High School and ICT in PCNHS main.
- c. Coaches should submit photocopy and original school identification to the contest administrator prior to the solidarity meeting. Failure to comply will mean the contestant or the output of the contestant will not be judged. Refer to Dep-Ed Memo No. 166, s. 2013.
- d. An amount of P272.00 shall be given per contestant to cover transportation and daily allowance chargeable against SEF fund (STEP 2014) while P230.00 will be collected per contestant to cover token for outside judges, certificates and some contest materials chargeable against STEP, School and other local funds subject to auditing rules and regulations.
- e. Solidarity meeting for 30 minutes will follow just after the opening program in the different contest venues. Coaches should observe time management.
- f. Contestant should wear their STEP uniform or white t-shirt during the contest.
- g. It is suggested that contested skills should be judged in an open judging system. Outside judges will be oriented on the said judging system to do the same.
- h. Coach-judges should reveal/clarify to the contestant the consensus score of coach-judges or whatever score the contestant obtained in a particular criteria. This will eliminate the discontentment of the contestant especially to those who will not win in the contest.
- i. Coach-judges are not allowed to sum-up or rank the results of the judging. No erasures shall be made in the score sheet. Coach-judge should affix his/her signature in the score sheet using ballpen/signpen before submitting it to the tabulation committee by the contest administrator.
- j. Officials attending/travelling to the different venue is on official business.
- k. Winners will be announced only by the tabulators.
