

DANCE WARS

March 14, 2015 1pm

- Dance Wars is a dance group competition. Part of the proceeds will be donated to The Pedal and Paddles Project: Bayanihang Bangka at Bisikleta.
- This is open for all high school students in Baguio. The participants must provide any proof that they are bonafide high school students upon registration.
- A group must have 5-10 members. Each members must submit a waiver to the organizers signed by themselves and their corresponding parent/guardian.
- The groups will be judged for two rounds.

Round 1

- Each group will present a 90-second themed routine
- The organizers Dance Works will announce the theme during a briefing after the registration period

Round 2

- Each group will present their main routine (Minimum of 3mins, maximum of 5mins)
- Any genre is allowed for this round. Concept or theme is left to the discretion of the participants.
- If the routine will include stunts and props, the group must inform the organizers immediately for safety purposes.
- Spectators will have the chance to show their support for the different competing groups by voting in the voting booth to be held inside the event area throughout the event.
- The final scores will comprise of the following:

Round 1	35%
Round 2	50%

Criteria for judging for both rounds:

Originality & Creativity	20%
Choreography	20%
Audience Impact	10%
Overall Performance	50%

People's Choice 15%

- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners will receive Php 3,000.00, Php 2, 000 and Php 1,000 cash and other tokens.
- Registration will be on February 23 27, 2015 at UP Baguio Alumni Center Lobby from 8am to 6pm. Registration is P50.00 per member of the group.
