3. Apply Montessori inspired movements inside their classrooms.
4. Use ethnic music and movement activities and indigenous musical instruments in their kindergarten classes.

The participants to this International Conference on Early Childhood Education are Kindergarten /Elementary Teachers (specially newly hired teachers who are in need of the necessary training, School Administrators , Academic Heads, Head Teachers, Principals, Kindergarten Coordinators, District and Education Supervisors, Directors and Owners of Private Schools.




