A. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Philippine Government

- a. Candidate must have rendered at least three (3) years of service;
- b. Must hold a permanent appointment;
- c. Must have a college degree related to the field of study [or has sufficiently demonstrated ability and experience along the field of study;]
- d. Must have obtained at least a very satisfactory performance rating for two consecutive periods preceding the nomination
- e. Must not have a pending application for scholarship under another program; and
- f. Must have rendered the service obligation required under Executive Order 367 for scholarship recently concluded

B. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- DepEd will provide the salary of the nominee for the duration of the award
- 2. Donor Country

C. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS (DEPED)

- 1. Supporting documents to be submitted prior to screening and evaluation:
 - A letter of nomination addressed to the Chairman of DepEd Scholarship Committee signed by the Regional Director or his/her duly authorized official
 - Updated Personal Data Sheet/Resume with list of in-service training and seminars attended (Spell out acronyms of organizer/s and topic/s or subject/s of the training. Certificates of training NEED NOT be submitted)
 - c. Certified copy of statement of actual duties and responsibilities
 - d. Copy of passport

2. Other documentary requirements to be submitted if accepted:

- a. Certified copy of service record
- b. Photocopy of Diploma (Baccalaureate/graduate)
- c. Photocopy of Transcript of Records (Baccalaurete/graduate)
- d. Certification that the nominee has no pending scholarship nomination to other program
- e. Certification that the nominee has no pending administrative and/or criminal case
- f. Certification from the school/division that the nominee has no financial and office accountabilities
- g. Scholarship Contract

D. PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS (SEAMEO SEN)

a. Proficient in English

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SCHOLARSHIP ADVISORY

- Must be in excellent health condition (a medical certificate accomplished by a
 government physician certifying that the participant is medically fit for a 4-week
 programme is to be attached to the course application form)
- c. Should not be more than 50 years of age
- d. Should not be an expectant mother (for female participant)
- e. Course requirements can be found in the attached general information regarding the courses

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
