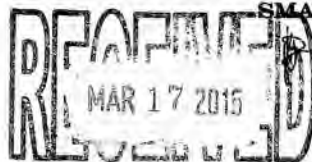



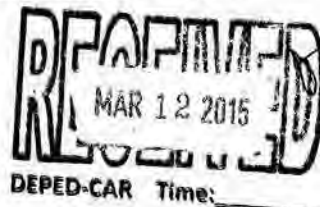

## ACADEMIC CONTEST

### General Guidelines:

1. Only official delegates are entitled to join.
2. The official delegates must indicate in their confirmation form that they are joining the contest on or before **April 10, 2015**.
3. Prizes include **medals and certificate of recognition and participation**.

### A. QUIZ BOWL

Topics: Climate Change, National and International Environmental Issues,

- Each school is entitled to have 3 contestants to compose a team who are bona fide students of the school.
- Each team will be provided with an illustration board to write their answers on together with a chalk and an eraser. They must raise their answers when the Quizmaster tells that time is up. Late answers will not be accepted.
- Questions shall prepared solely by the SMARTER Board Members.
- The questions will be read twice by the Quizmaster. After the second reading, the Quizmaster will say "GO"- only then will the team be allowed to write the answer.
- The contest has three (3) rounds. Level 1 - 5 questions for EASY ROUND - 1 point, Level 2 - 5 questions for AVERAGE ROUND - 2 points and Level 3 - 5 questions for DIFFICULT ROUND - 3 points.
- After the 15 questions, 5 teams getting the highest score will be declared Champion, 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up, 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up, 3<sup>rd</sup> Runner-up, and 4<sup>th</sup> Runner-up.
- The duly registered teacher-coach of the team is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately before the Quizmaster.

### B. EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEECH

#### Mechanics:

- The topic shall be given on the spot by the judges.
- The contestants shall be given 3 minutes to deliver.
- Speeches should be delivered in English.
- The style of the delivery shall be conversational, oratorical or a combination of both.
- The contestant should not wear his/her school uniform.
- Use of sound, effects, microphones and props is strictly prohibited.
- The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.



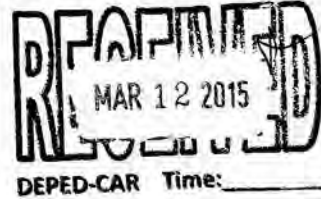

## C. PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

- Participants may use any digital or film-based camera. Entries must be printed in full color on any brand of photo paper in 8R size.
- Creative effects done within the camera at the time of exposure are allowed.
- Digital retouching on density, contrast adjustments, minor cropping, burning, and dodging may be tolerated, although major manipulation of main images through adding or subtracting are not allowed.
- The name of the contestant must not appear in the entry.

- Each group must use the given template for the proposal. Any changes in the template may result to cessation of the proposal from the competition.
- The presentation of the proposal should not exceed 25 minutes. Each group should plan on a 15 minute formal presentations that exceed their time limits will be penalized.
- Participants should provide four copies of their project proposal for the panel of Judges is final and irrevocable.
