Greetings!

In celebration of Women's Month in Baguio City, we shall be holding a one-day Ecological Fair on March 21, 2015 from 8:00 – 6:00 PM at the People's Park.

The Ecological Fair, an exhibit, fair and competition of the best crafts from recycled materials is open to students, women and the general public. It is governed by the following mechanics:

1. The Ecological Fair shall be held on March 21, 2015 from 8:00AM – 6:00PM at the People's Park;
2. Only crafts made from recycled materials such as plastics, used paper; twigs & leaves, pvc, styrofoam, and others are qualified to join.
3. Only **one (1)** entry per school/ group/organization shall be accepted to the competition.
4. The entries shall be classified into **three (3) categories**:

**Category 1 – Elementary Level**

**Category 2 - High School Level**

**Category 3 - Open category (College, groups, clubs, organizations, agencies)**

5. Size of entry for all categories must be not more that 2 feet.
6. All entries for the competition must signify its functionality/usage.

7. Entries must be submitted to the Secretariat, or the office of the undersigned, not later than 8:00 AM of March 21, 2015 at the People's Park. Display of entries shall be up to 6:00 PM only.
8. Judging will be done anytime within the day. After the judging, non-winning entries shall be returned back to the owner on the same day.
9. The top 3 winning entries in each category shall be displayed at the City Hall lobby for one week, starting March 23 up to March 27, 2015. They shall be returned back to the owner after the display.
10. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Originality/Uniqueness	-	20%
Craftsmanship (Quality)	-	20%
Aesthetic design	-	20%
Selection and use of materials	-	20%
Functionality	-	20%
Total .....		<b>100%</b>
