- · The main body of the abstract should contain no more than 500 words
- When submitting an abstract, please include: an introductory statement that outlines the
 background and significance of the study a succinct description of the basic methodologies a
 clear indication of the major findings of the study a concluding statement
- Please be guided as well on the following abstract review criteria:
 - o the conference topics Significance of the scientific question(s) and results -
 - Style Organization (e.g., the abstract has a clear beginning, middle and end) -
 - o Clear question or hypothesis -
 - Sufficient background The experimental approach and rationale for the approach are clear -
 - The results are clearly presented –
 - The interpretation and conclusions are reasonable and logical


