SURVEY QUESTIONNAIRE FOR INCOMING SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL PRINCIPALS HEAD TEACHERS & TEACHER -IN-CHARGE

- By June 2016, enrolment to Senior High School (SHS) shall be mandatory for all Junior High completers. In preparation for SY 2016-2017, activities like the initial identification of student track choice were conducted last year.
- To validate the data obtained, the Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) through the School Management Monitoring and Evaluation Section (SMME Section) designed a survey questionnaire to be administered to both private and public incoming Grade 11 students and their parents. Kindly see Enclosure 1(Survey Questionnaire for Parents) and Enclosure 2 (Survey Questionnaire for Students).
- Prior to answering the survey form, it is expected that a thorough discussion of the questionnaire contents be conducted with students on the track and strand preference or occupational interests.
