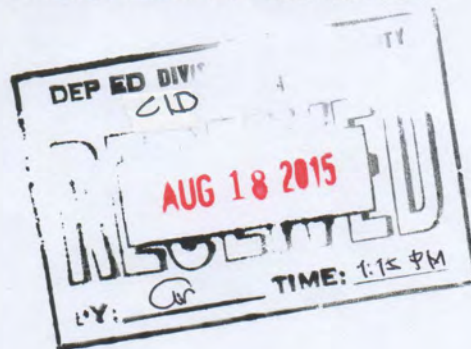
Subject: **COMMEMORATION of the 137th BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF MANUEL L. QUEZON**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 146, s. 2014 entitled "2015 Conduct of National Observances and Commemoration of Historical Events and related activities" the 137th Birth Anniversary of Manuel Quezon will be commemorated on August 19, 2015 in the different schools.
2. This significant date in the Philippine History marks the birth of a man who became the first Commonwealth President, the Father of Philippine Independence, and Ama ng Wikang Filipino, and considered as the greatest Filipino statesman.
3. To make this year's commemoration more meaningful, all public and private schools are encouraged to carry out activities integrated in related subject areas such as Araling Panlipunan, Values Education, Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health, Filipino, and English during classroom discussions to highlight the qualities and achievements of Pres. Manuel L. Quezon as President and statesman.
4. The Quezon's Code of citizenship and Ethics (English and Filipino versions) for the Filipino people shall be used as a learning resource for the young to re-learn the values and moral character, personal discipline, civic conscience, and the duties of citizenship as a part of the Filipino heritage.
