CONCEPT NOTE

A Better Future for Every Learner in Southeast Asia

The 14TH SEAMEO INNOTECH International Conference

08 to 09 December 2015

Background and Purpose

SEAMEO INNOTECH has the mandate to generate new technologies and innovative solutions to develop the full potential of the peoples of Southeast Asia. Every two years, the Centre convenes an international conference to bring together new ideas, diverse perspectives and experiences garnered by education stakeholders in the region and beyond. The Conference serves as a platform for focused conversations on key issues on education and development. It serves as a way for the Centre to promote its knowledge products and solutions. The Conference seeks to surface fresh insights, emerging theories and effective practices to enrich the research and innovation agenda of the Centre. The IC also highlights the SEAMEO INNOTECH brand of service through its innovative and engaging learning experiences for participants.

The 14th SEAMEO INNOTECH International Conference will move away from the traditional gathering of educators. The two-day future-oriented forum will also include youth leaders to encourage collaboration between educators and learners and expand their networks.

The youth-oriented focus for the 14th SEAMEO INNOTECH International Conference is inspired, in part, by the global discourse on setting an agenda for development and education. The young are the principal stakeholders in the emergent education and learning landscape. It is essential for their voice to be heard by the policy-makers amid competing interests and concerns. This is best articulated by the former UNESCO Director of Basic Education and DepEd Undersecretary, Dr. Victor Ordonez (2008), when, citing Mark Peasely, he had described the emerging reality where

"students think differently from us... they develop hypertext minds...they leap around... their cognitive structures are parallel, not sequential." They do homework with i-pod earphones on, watching a television screen that often has a running subscript, pop-ups and side bars of information. And they seem to absorb it all. Ninety-eight percent (98%) of urban students play video games (becoming an industry that has outgrown formal schooling), but only 37 % of their teachers have even tried one.

How do we close the divide between technological native learners; and the technology immigrant educators? Ushering in Centre's 9th Five Year Development Plan, the IC/14 is expected to give the Centre an opportunity to promote the programs even as the specific projects and activities may be refined by taking into account the views of the learners and youth leaders. These issues, among others, shall be explored through the two-day intensive dialogue with a view towards giving voice to the young people's views on how to shape the future of education in the region.

Prospective Participants

This Conference will focus on the youth and their reflections on improving the quality of education in the region. Amidst the various fora engaging different stakeholders to shape a successor agenda to the Education for All (EFA) goals and action program forged in Jomtien (1990) and Dakar (2000), the voice of the youth – those who will eventually take up leadership roles and responsibilities is an essential ingredient.

As part of engaging the youth, we will be harnessing the dominating influence of social media and technology popular in youth culture today.

Complementing the voice of the youth would be the participation of education and development leaders in the region, promising nuanced and innovative approaches to fulfilling the EFA goals articulated in the global discourse. Southeast Asia's demographics indicate that it is a region peopled by the young, and most SEA societies are getting younger.

Conference Design and Methodology

Applying Open Space Technology as the principal conference methodology, the participants – comprising mainly of youth delegates – will have the opportunity to converse on issues they are passionate about. The methodology creates the space in which crucial and diverse viewpoints, issues and ideas are raised, deliberated and questioned. Underpinning it is the fundamental respect for individuals and the belief that everyone in the discussion has something to contribute that needs to be heard. The Conference, tapping into the collective wisdom of the participants, will carry forward action points about future possibilities of learning and education in the region.

It will culminate in a collective planning process to come up with a Southeast Asian young people's education agenda. In the final session of the Conference, this Education Agenda will be presented to Senior Officials of the Ministries of Education in Southeast Asia for their response and action.

While primarily an opportunity for youth-led thought-leadership, the Conference will also allow opportunities for educators and other stakeholders engaged in youth development initiatives to identify innovative strategies and approaches to support an inclusive youth education agenda for the region.

Conference Activities

Aside from the participatory nature of the development of the Conference program, other associated events are envisaged to be organized in association with the 14th International Conference. These associated events may be developed with the participation of the partners and co-organizers.

The broad Conference design will feature the following:

- Keynote presentations by eminent invited speakers (to be presented live, real-time tele
 presentations, or pre-recorded messages) articulating the perspectives from the young
- Poster presentations on specific issues and special interests
- Focused group discussion and conversations

- Exhibition of knowledge products and tools; and
- Continuing networking sessions among others

Partnerships

To ensure broad participation in the 14th International Conference, the efforts at promoting the IC/14 would focus on the strategic partnerships established and nurtured by the Centre engaging stakeholders groups and institutions. Support of various partners will be sought to enable participation of the ordinary teachers, education workers and students who may not have the institutional support.


Private corporations, international organizations, foundations and bilateral development agencies, among others, will be tapped to support youth leaders. The promotion and marketing activities for the Conference also spring from the over-all partnership strategy, whereby institutional support from partners will be the anchor intervention. Face to face and intensive presentations and promotions will be done with key institutions, including the Ministries of Education, international organizations, mass media institutions, and other key partners.

Most of the youth are online and connected, even those outside the education systems. Social media can be an effective tool to reach our audience and participants but can also be a great platform for our partners and sponsors to get their messages across through us. Social media can also help promote the conference through the social media channels of our partners and sponsors, thus exponentially widening our reach.

Conference Aims and Objectives

The 14th SEAMEO INNOTECH International Conference aligns to the SEAMEO INNOTECH purpose of promoting, identifying and helping solve common problems as well as anticipate education development needs in the region. The Center likewise assists SEAMEO Member States in identifying solutions to education concerns in individual countries. The two-day forum is envisaged to give the opportunity for young people and education policy makers, practitioners and other stakeholders to come together in dialogue and together shape the education development agenda for the region.

At the end of the two-day conversation, innovative and practical inputs for the development agenda for education in the region, bringing together the views and sentiments of the youth and nuanced by the experienced and pragmatic thoughts of mature educators is expected to emerge. These inputs for the education agenda would be presented to the SEAMEO High Officials and Council of Ministers as inputs towards elaborating the region's education agenda.

Ground Rules and Reminders

The 14th SEAMEO INNOTECH International Conference is a youth-oriented gathering open to participants aged 15 years and above. SEAMEO INNOTECH, as the conference organizer, affirms its belief in the young leaders of the region who are imbued strength of character, discipline and a more outward looking world view. Participants are thus expected to practice and internalize some of the Center's core values that emphasize respect for diversity, inclusiveness, and a sincere desire to learn from and share with other participants.

With that in mind, following are some reminders on what is expected of participants in SEAMEO INNOTECH learning sessions in order to ensure a safe, pleasant and non-threatening learning environment that is conductive to productive reflection and meaningful discussion:

- SEAMEO INNOTECH maintains a drug-free and tobacco-free environment in keeping with Philippine Laws and city ordinances. Use of illegal drugs and drinking alcoholic beverage, including drunken or unruly behaviour are not permitted during sessions. Smoking is not allowed inside the SEAMEO INNOTECH grounds.
