On-the-spot Painting Competition

Project Description:

Early this year, in our aim to address the need to establish an institution dedicated to teaching visual arts to children, Musar Music Corporation created the Home of Music and Arts. Classes are currently handled by some of the brightest local artists here in Baguio City. Some of our projects over the past months include an on-the-spot painting demonstration held at SM Baguio's Art Gallery and a live painting exhibition held at the Baguio Convention Center Lobby-both of which were designed to showcase our students' development under our program. In line with the celebration of the 106th Baguio Charter Day, the Home of Music and Arts in partnership the Baguio Tourism Council under Mr. Benny Alhambra and Department of Education, would like to invite the young aspiring artists (elementary and high school), to our first ARTS On-the spot-Painting Competition.

Objective:

The competition aims to instill to the younger generation the nurturing values of creative expression and its respective social and cultural functions through their artworks. With the theme, "Fostering social awareness and cultural sensitivity through arts," the students are expected to depict Baguio City's rich culture and heritage through their landscapes, portraitures and still lives.

Painting Competition Mechanics:

A. Eligibility

1. The competition is open to Elementary and High School Students.
2. One student per school for the Elementary category and for the High School Category will be chosen **by the school** to proceed for the On-the-spot painting.
3. The school should submit the entry forms on or before September 15, 2015 at the Musar Ecco branch, Assumption road from 9:00am- 6:00pm. Please see Mr. Shule T. Ozo for further instructions; Mobile #:09269518999

B. Judging On-the-spot painting

1. The theme for the competition is "Fostering social awareness and cultural sensitivity through Arts."
2. Only one painting per student is allowed.
3. All the artworks will be judged by a panel of local artists, art critics and art teachers of well-known art institutions in Baguio City.

Judges will select the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placers and two consolation prizes for the Elementary category and 1st, 2nd and 3rd placers and two consolation prizes for the High School category.

4. The decision of the panel of judges is final.
5. Announcement of winners will be on September 21, 4-5pm at the Baguio Convention Lobby

C. Prizes

1. The awarding of winning artworks will be held at the student's school . Winning artworks will be exhibited at the SM City Baguio Exhibit Gallery after the competition.

2nd Prize: P3,000.00 and a Trophy

3rd Prize: P2,000.00 and a Trophy

High School Division:

1st Prize: P5,000.00 ,a Trophy , Guitar and Amplifier Showcase for the Student's School

2nd Prize: P3,000.00 and a Trophy

3rd Prize: P2,000.00 and a Trophy

Consolation Prizes (2): Scholarship for 12 Music Lessons at Musar Music or Art Lessons at the Musar's Home of Music and Arts.
