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

**GUIDELINES ON THE 2015 DISTRICT MATHEMATICS FESTIVAL
QUEZON AND NORTH QUEZON DISTRICT**

TO : School Administrators, Principals, Head Teachers
Secondary Math Teachers
(Public and Private Schools)

1. The 2015 District Mathematics Festival is scheduled on **September 26, 2015** at San Vicente National High School. Attached are the guidelines and mechanics as well as the processes agreed in the conduct of all contests in the District of Quezon and North Quezon.
2. The guidelines specify the procedures in administering each contested areas in Quiz Bee, DAMATH, SUDOKU, in which the different working committees are identified for systematic flow.
3. All District Mathematics officers are expected to be at the venue before the official time to ensure that all rooms and materials are ready for the event.
4. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

**GUIDELINES FOR THE 2015 DISTRICT MATHEMATICS FESTIVAL
QUEZON AND NORTH QUEZON DISTRICT**

DISTRICT MATH FESTIVAL: SEPTEMBER 26, 2015 (Saturday)
TIME: 8:30 A.M. onwards
VENUE: San Vicente National High School
REGISTRATION FEE: Php 40.00 per student contestant - to be given during the contest day

A. QUIZ BEE

1. **School:** Grade 7, 8, 9 – One representative each grade level for ORAL ELIMINATIONS
Grade 10 - One for WRITTEN ELIMINATION
- Two for ORAL ELIMINATION (Team)
* **TOP 4** contestants will be qualified to the DIVISION LEVEL

2. **Tasks:** Every school to submit **4 questions each for EASY and AVERAGE**
4 questions each for DIFFICULT and CLINCHER

***K to 12 content**

* To be printed on a short bond paper (**ARIAL 12**) WITH ANSWERS.

*To be submitted during the contest day

* Four (4) questions on every short bond paper. (8.5" x 11")

B. DAMATH - One contestant per grade level.

TOP 6 contestants will move to the DIVISION LEVEL

***Note: Calculator is allowed.**

C. SUDOKU - One contestant per school regardless of the grade level.

TOP 3 contestants will move to the DIVISION LEVEL

QUIZ BEE GUIDELINES

1. Each contestant will be provided with slips of paper for the answer to each question. Before the contest proper, the contestant will write the assigned number on each slip.
2. There shall be 20 questions. There are four (4) rounds in each competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie. Questions will be read twice by the Quizmaster.
 - a. For the EASY ROUND, ten questions are to be answered mentally. Writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. is not allowed. After the second (2nd) reading, the Quizmaster shall say "go". Only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. Automatically, the ten (15) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
 - b. For the AVERAGE ROUND, five questions are to be answered. After the first (1st) reading, the contestants are allowed to start solving and write their final answer on the slip of paper. Automatically, the thirty (30) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
 - c. For the DIFFICULT ROUND, five questions are to be answered. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve, and write their answer. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
 - d. For the CLINCHER ROUND, as many questions as needed are to be answered. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve, and write their answer. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
3. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
4. After the time limit and the buzzer sounds, the contestants must stop writing and raise the slip of paper.
5. The Quizmaster shall read and verify the contestants' answer.
6. Points are assigned for each question answered correctly:

. Easy question	1 point
. Average question	3 points
. Difficult question	5 points
. Clincher question	5 points
7. After the fifth (5th) question in the Difficult Round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.
8. The contestant will be ranked according to their total score. The top four will proceed to the Division Level.
9. In case any qualified contestant is unable to compete in the next contest level, the next in rank will take the place of the contestant.
10. The duly registered teacher - coach or contestant are authorized to make a protest.
11. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
12. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/ protests.
