Dear Sir,

In accordance with **Republic Act No. 10627 or the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013** and the **DepEd Child Protection Policy**, the **Iskolarni Kuya (INK) Foundation**, and **JEM Talents Central Productions**, in cooperation with the **Rotary Club of Downtown Session**, will conduct a nation-wide caravan on bullying entitled **“REASONS TO SAY NO! TO BULLYING”**.

The objectives of the anti-bullying caravan are the following:


- a) Nationwide forum and film viewing to the youth via schools about the bullying problem,
- b) Self awareness of the people’s own possible contribution to this situation;
- c) Educate the Filipino youth to contribute to a safer and peaceful school environment.

The speakers who will take part on the activity are former victims of bullying that were able to cope up and stand up against bullying. Their stories will inspire the youth on what to do when faced by this situation. Highlight of the forum is the anti-bullying film **“MARKA”**. The film can be shown to elementary and high school students and the target date of the film viewing will be at the end of September 2015 at SM Cinemas. The ticket cost will be at P175 per student and teachers are free of charge. We will also ask the City Government of Baguio if they can subsidize the whole amount or part of the ticket cost.

In relation to this, may we ask for your support by endorsing this advocacy to the public schools in Baguio City.


Hoping for your positive response. Let’s all together make a stand against bullying.


