**Requirements:**

6. Duly accomplished registration forms
7. Original medical certificate
8. Photocopy of Red Cross membership ID
9. Youth participants must have a certification duly signed by the PRC Baguio RCY Staff and PRC Chapter Administrator
10. The Adviser must have a certification duly signed by the PRC Baguio RCY Staff, PRC Chapter Administrator and the School Head.

**Qualifications:**

Youth

- Must be 15 – 25 yrs old
- Must be a bona fide volunteer
- Have completed the Leadership Development Program
- Must been actively involved in RCY activities for a minimum of two(2) years for voting delegates and a minimum of one(1) year for observers.

**Adviser**

- Have completed the Organization Strategic Training or the Council Management Training
- At least two(2) years of active service to the organization

**Registration Fee: (Cash or Check payments payable to Philippine Red Cross)**

Youth Participants – P4,500.00

Advisers- P4,750.00

The registration fees shall cover meals, accommodation for the whole duration of the congress, souvenir items, as well as materials necessary for their participation in the different activities of the congress. Travelling expenses from the point of origin to the venue is **NOT** included in the fees.
